

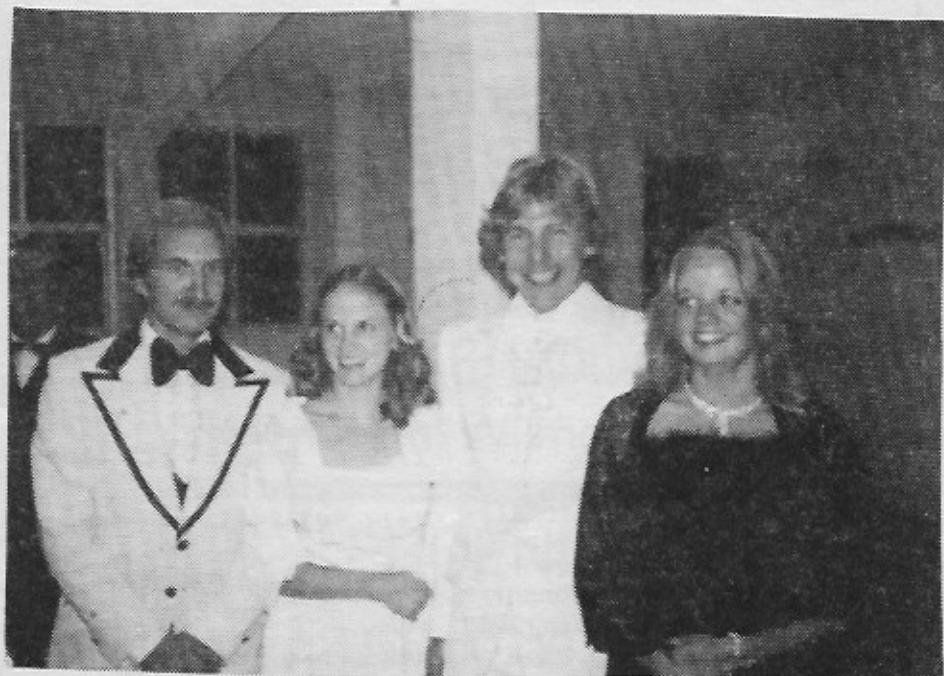

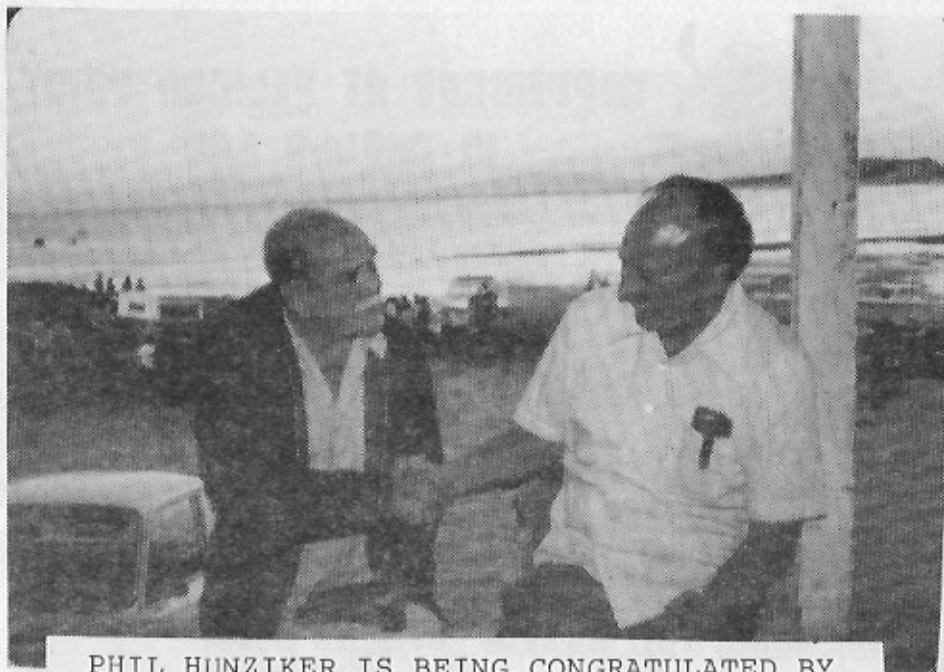
The Club made him and his wife, Jane paid-up life time members! And a Plaque was presented.

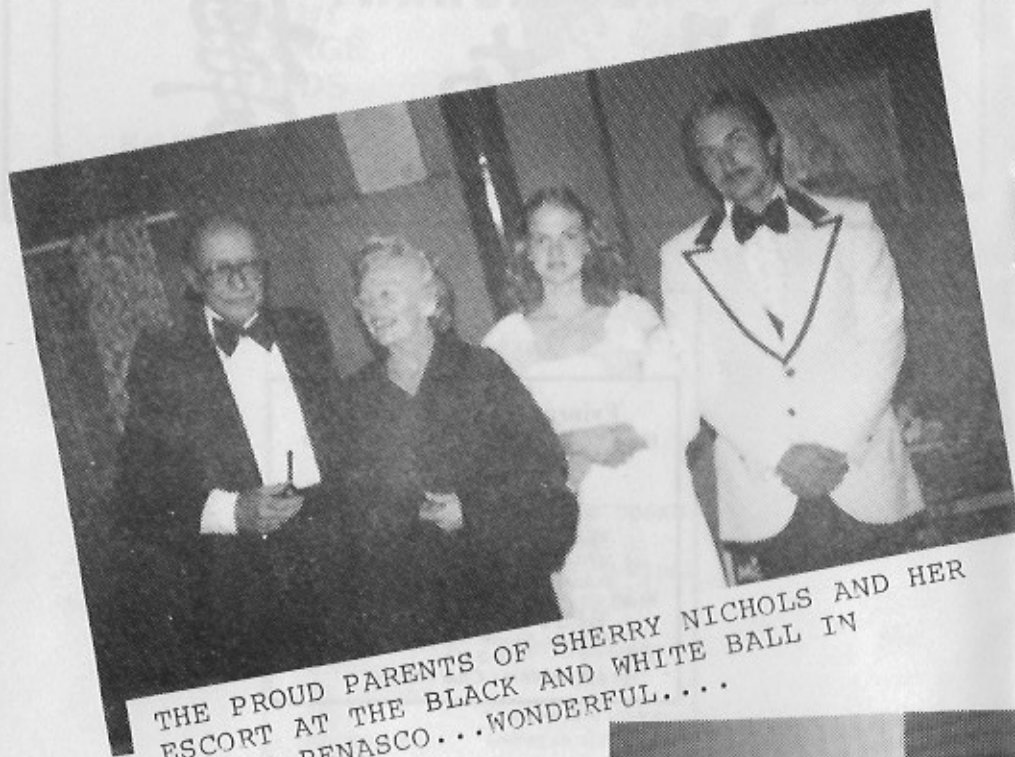

## THE 1979 ELECTION?

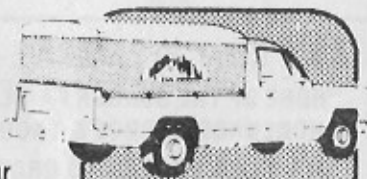

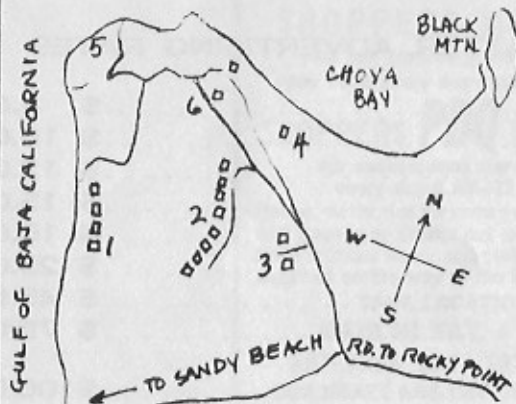

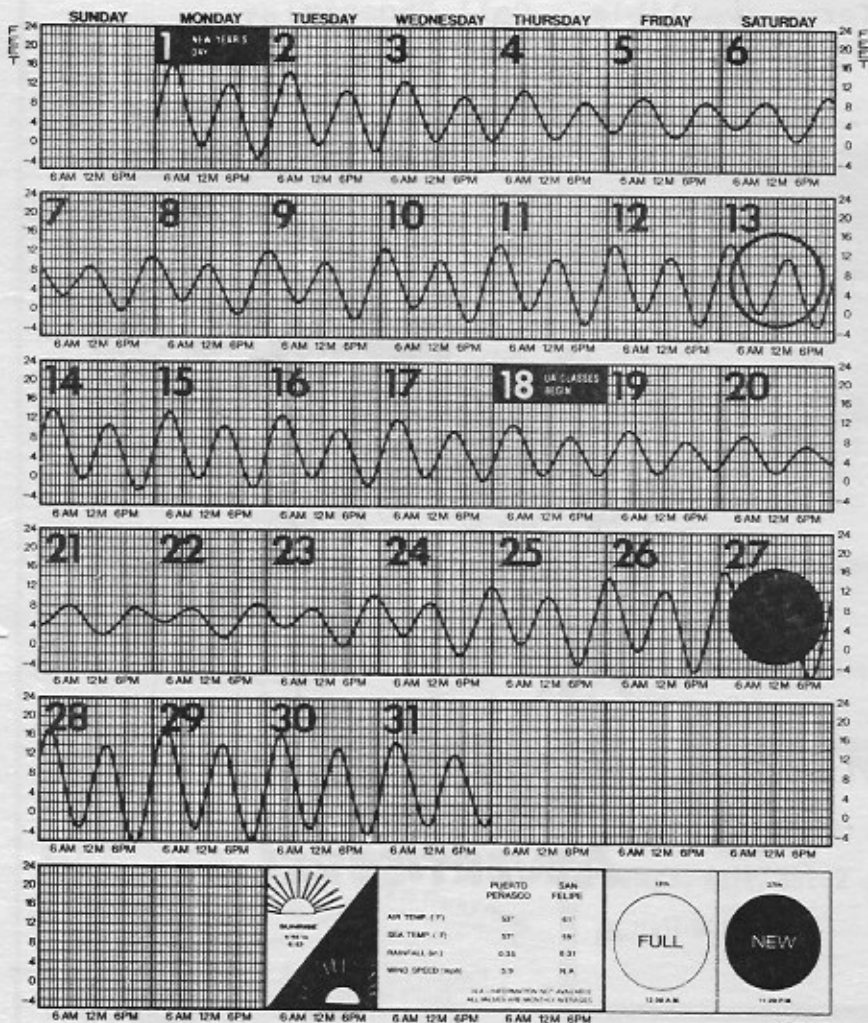
