

FRIED SHRIMP

Large shrimp 1/2 can milk 1 egg flour




Kelloggs Corn Flake crumbs

Clean and butterfly shrimp and have the following 3 steps ready

- Enough flour to coat each side of shrimp.
- 2. Milk and egg beaten together
- 3. Enough crumbs to coat shrimp

With finger tips, pound flour into both sides of the "little dears" and shake off excess. Dip into batter then into crumbs. Repeat the pounding of crumbs into both sides of the "little dears" making them wide and flat. Shake off excess. Fry in hot grease, turning once. Because of the thinness, the frying time is very short.

Water heaters recalled - More than 600,000 liquid-propane water heaters are being recalled to correct a defective valve believed to have caused 23 explosions, including five deaths. The water heaters, also believed to have caused 16 serious injuries, were sold between 1961 and 1980 by the A.O. Smith Corp. of Kankakee, Ill., by Sears Roebuck & Co. and by other manufacturers and retailers. In all, 56 brands of water heaters are involved.
