We want to thank all the participants in the derby, all of you who helped by buying jackpot tickets and all of those who sent in the very generous donations.

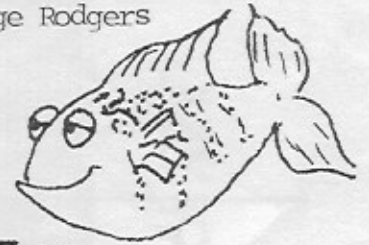

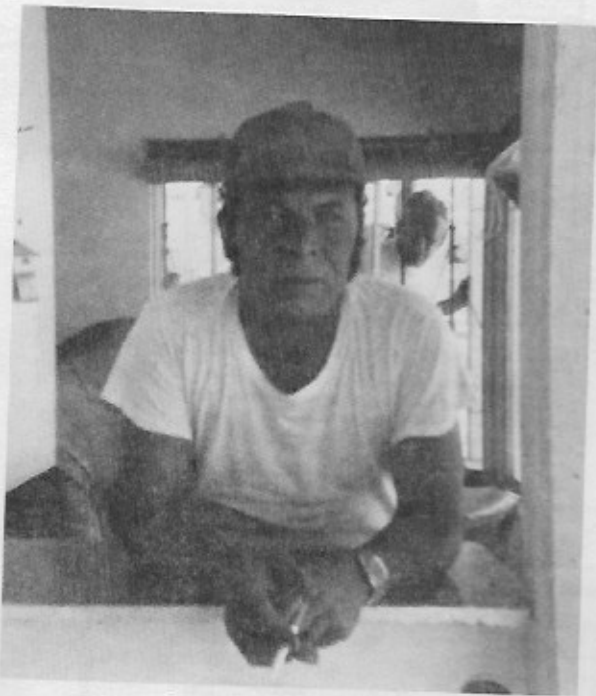

1981 SAILFISH AND DOLPHIN DERBY

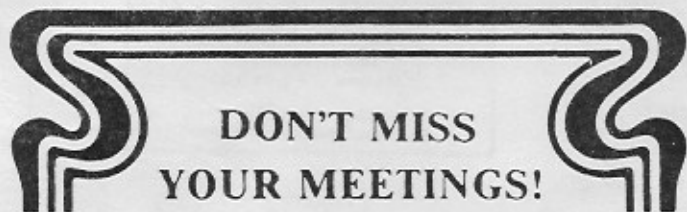

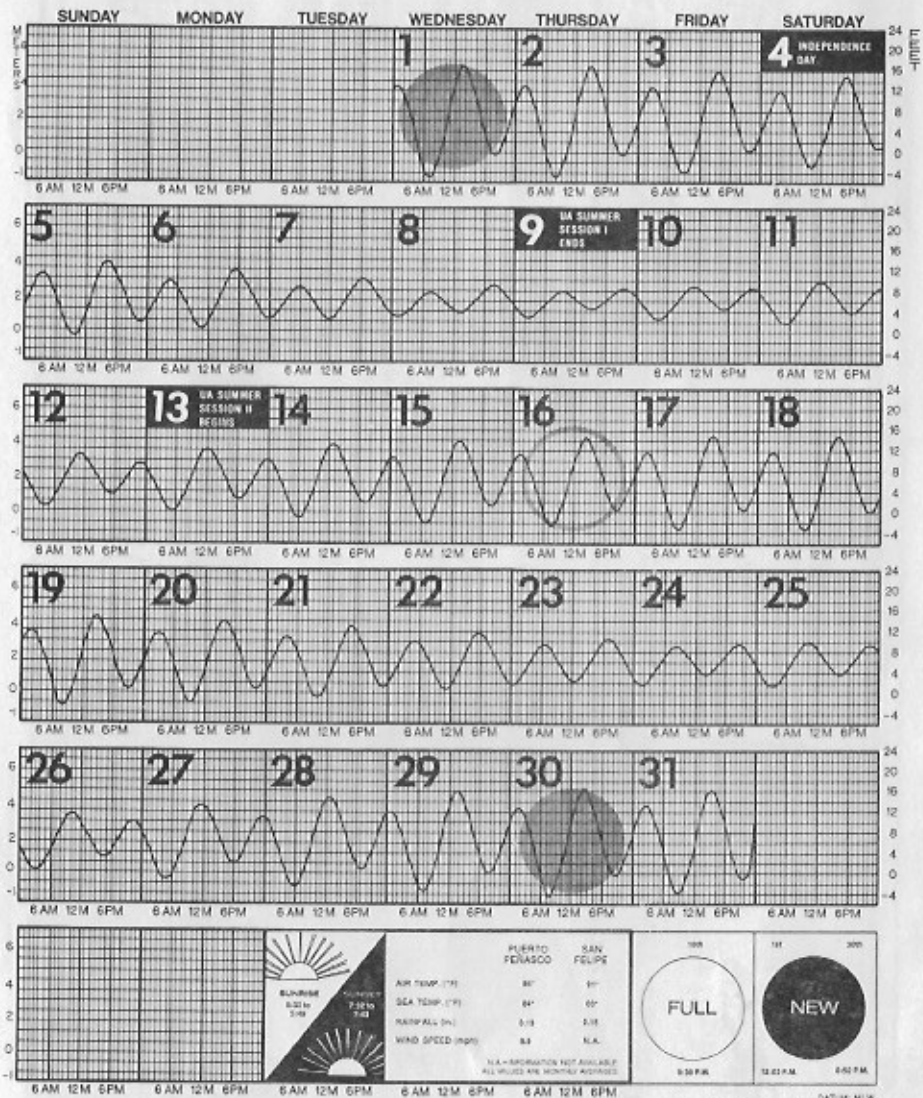
