Editor: We were greatly honored by so many Club Members having taken the time to attend our 60th Anniversary Open House here in Yarnell on July seventh.



As the years go by, and the pressures on recreational facilities north of the Border become more crowded, Rocky Point can only benefit, and the Club become more involved.

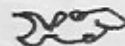
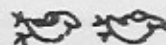
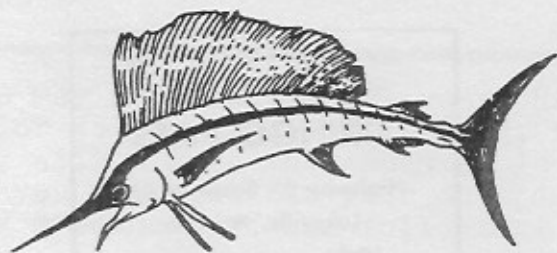
I am not sure, but I suspect that Florence and I - at 83 and 85 are the oldest couple that are still paying dues ?

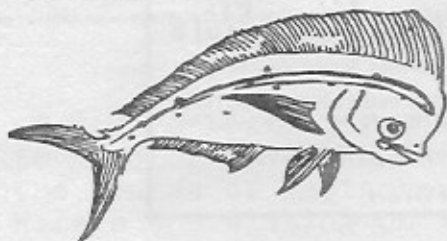

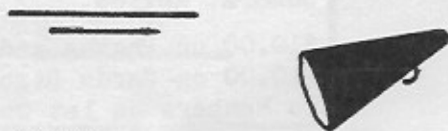

Thanks Noel, we really do appreciate your talent and your generosity.

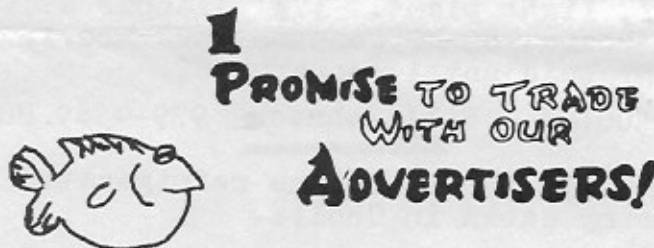

KAHLUA STIR-FRY CHICKEN

- 2 T. beaten egg
- $\frac{1}{4}$ C. plus 2 T. oil
- 2 T. cornstarch
- $1\frac{1}{2}$ # chicken - boned, skinned & cut into $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces.
- $\frac{1}{2}$ C. water chestnuts
- 6 asparagus tips, fresh or frozen
- 1 green pepper, cut in $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
- 4 oz. sliced mushrooms
- 4 oz. snow peas
- 3 T. Kahlua mixed with 1 t. cornstarch
- 1 C. cashews
- 3 green onions chopped fine

Coat chicken in mixture of egg, 2 T. oil & cornstarch. Heat remaining oil in wok. Add chicken, stir well, cook until golden. Drain well. Leaving very little oil in wok, add all vegetables except green onions. Stir-fry 3-5 mins. Add Kahlua-cornstarch mixture, stir well. Simmer. Add chicken and cashews, stir well. Transfer to heated platter. Garnish with green onions.

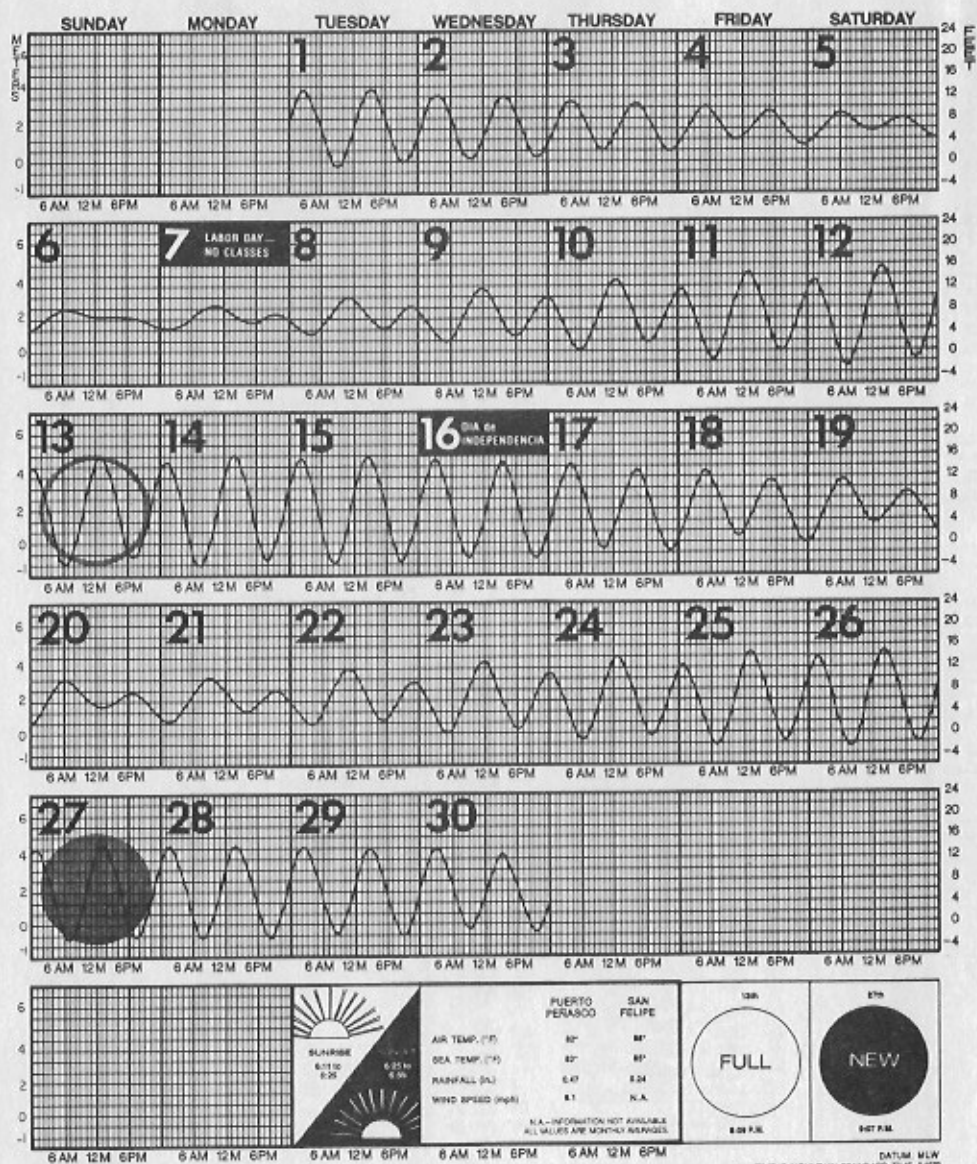
