


PHOENIX CHAPTER GENERAL MEETING Marie MacGill

HAPPENINGS AT PELICAN POINT By Marie MacGill


The wind and sand have still been stealing the show at the Bay and on Pelican Point, but it's very good to feel the nice autumn breezes.






