





CHEESE CAKE

20 Graham crackers (crushed) 1/8 lb. butter (melted) 1 tsp. Crisco

Roll crackers very fine, mix with butter. Grease spring-form pan with Crisco and line pan with cracker crumbs.

1 cup sugar 2 large and 1 small pkg. cream cheese 1/2 tsp. lemon juice 4 eggs

Cream sugar & cheese together, add lemon juice and eggs, beat well. Pour mixture into pan and bake for 40 min. at 350 degrees. Remove from oven and let cool 10 minutes.

Topping:
1/3 cup sugar 1 pint sowr cream
1 tsp vanilla

Mix well, pour mixture over cake and bake 20 min. Refrigerate at least 6 hours.



We now have two contests for trophies and patches.

Our Big 10 has been in existance for some time. To complete your card; any combination of six alternate fish along with four required fish may be submitted. All qualifying fish must be weighed and verified by a committee member.

Our Mini 5 began in 1983 and is accomplished in essentially the same manner except the eligibility categories have been reduced as have overall catch requirements. A limited selection of 9 species of which 2 fish are required and 3 others used as alternates.

REMEMBER -- Have fish weighed and verified and entered on your card by a committee member, Augustin at the Radio Shack, Rojo, Joan Dernberger, George Rodgers.


Pancho loved and was very devoted to his job as head of the Fishing Department of Sonora, Mexico. He was always looking for a way to expand sports fishing in Mexico.




