

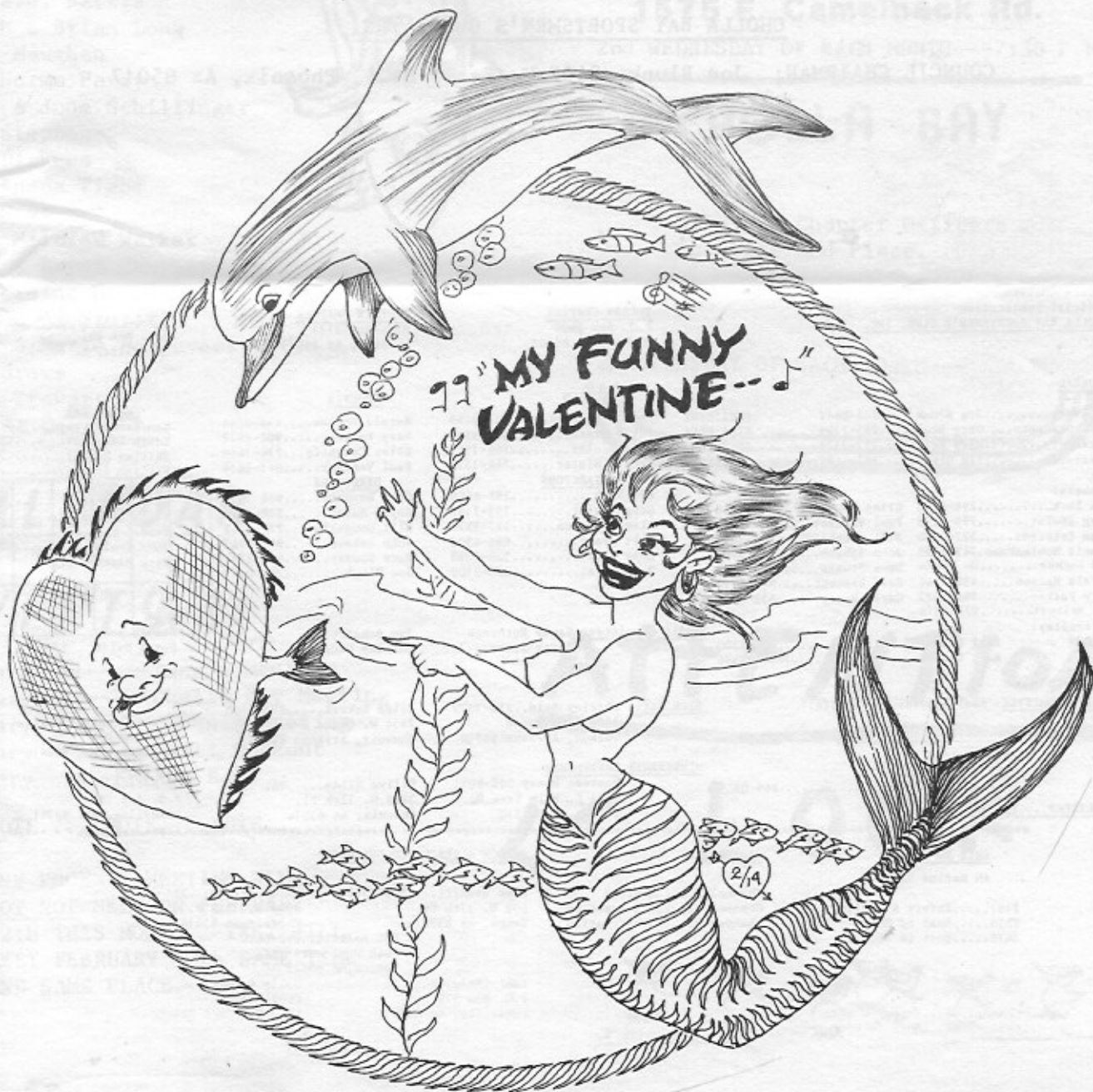

Through all eternity.

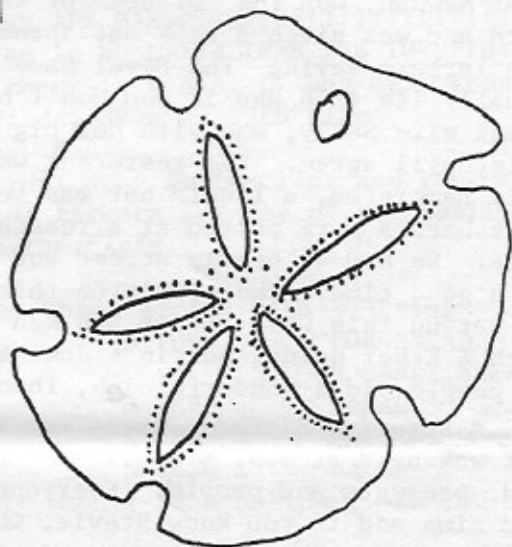
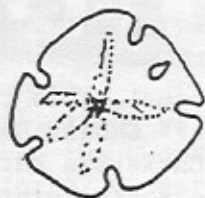
Have you seen a starfish
