

Taken from Puerto Penasco Newspaper Dec. 30, 1986

After a recent accident inolving a minor driving a car without a license the folling has been called to our attention. Many parents of minors (under the legal driving age of 18) are letting their children learn to drive and most of thse children do not know the difference between the brake and the gas pedal. Before we let these minors off with a warning and calling the attention to their parents. But this isn't working and the police cheif says that now any one caught under 18 years of age driving will have their vehicle confiscated, there will be a fine,

and the minor put on probation in custody of their parents. The legal age for driving a car in Mexico is 18 and for 3 wheelers and motorcycles is 14 years. As you read above the legal age for driving 3 wheelers and or motorcycles. The police are asking that you keep a close watch on your children when letting them use car, 3 wheeler, or motorcycle. There have been several bad, fatal and near fatal accidents.
