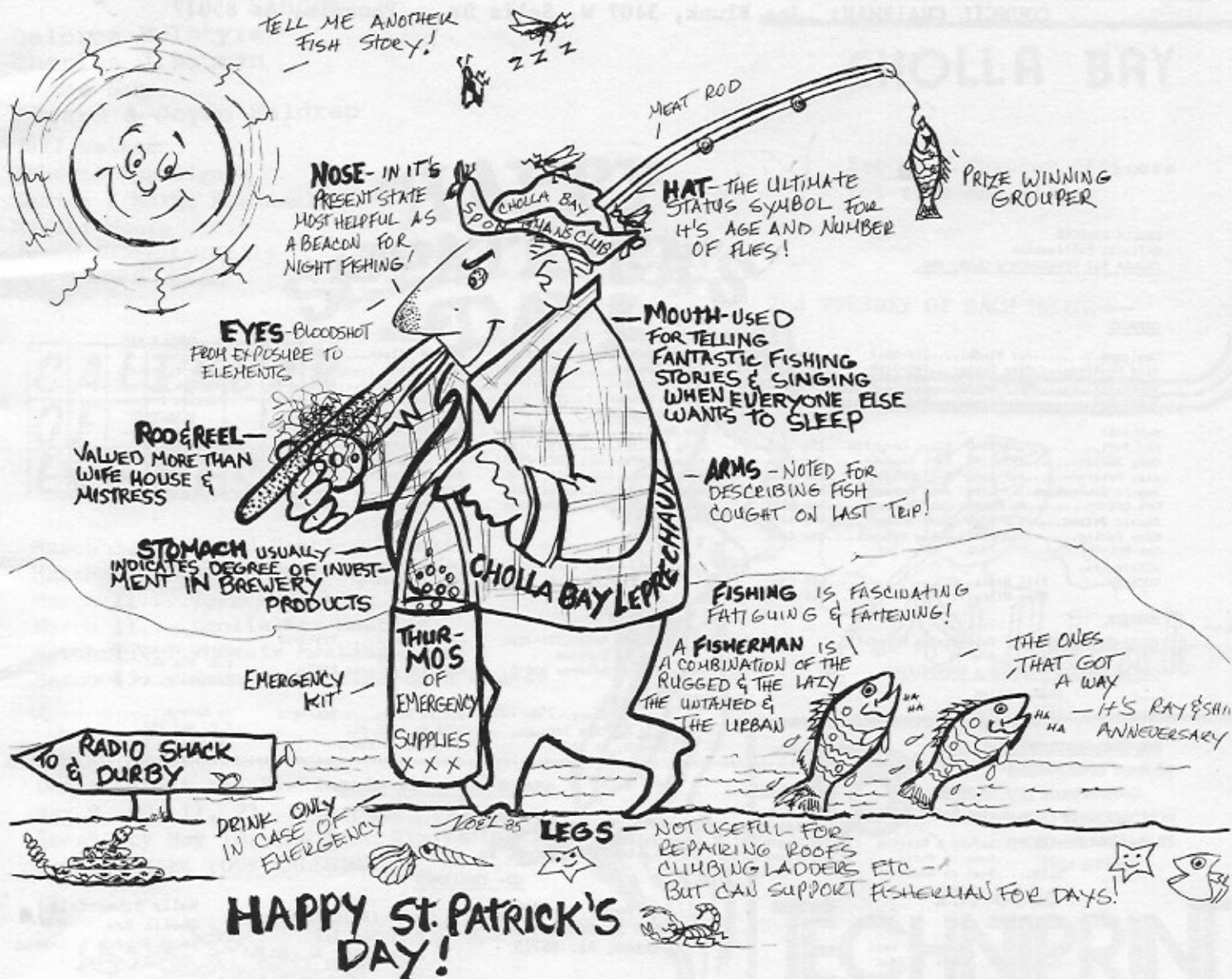

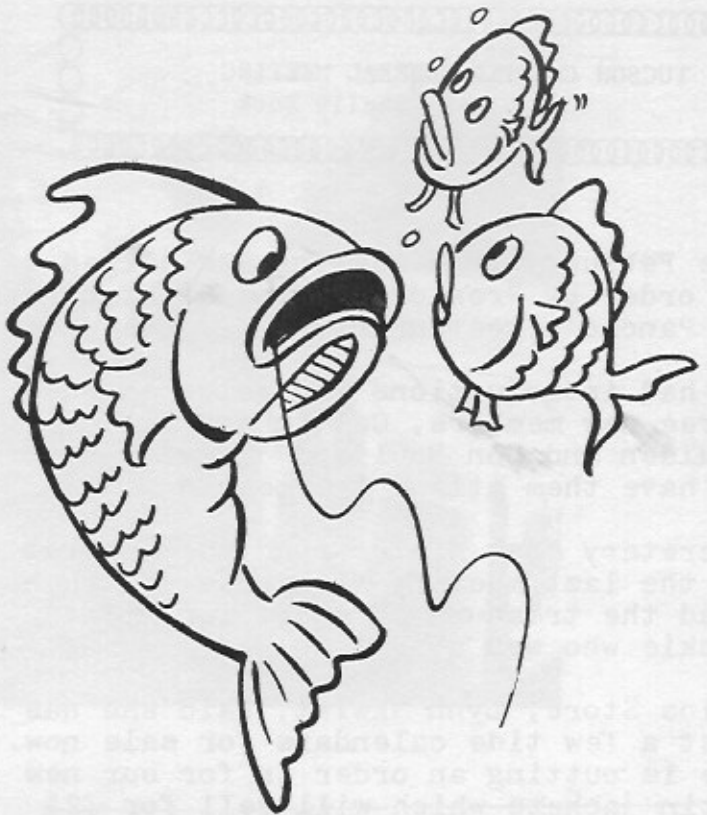

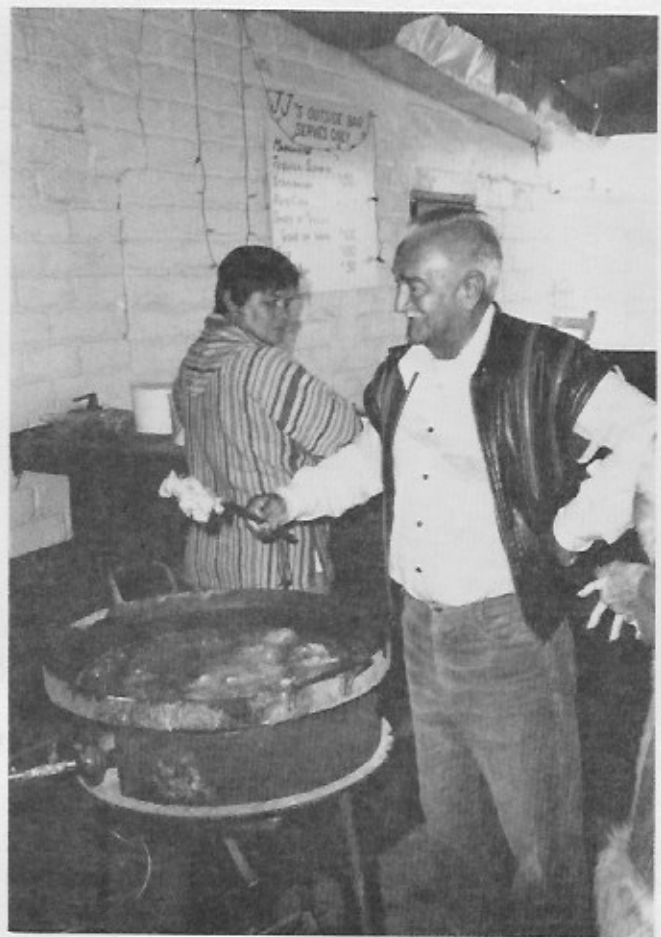

Until the weekend of President's Day the month of February was fairly calm with little to report, BUT the long weekend made up for it.

On Saturday two hobi-cats with two men on each capized; Three of the men were accounted for but the fourth man was missing. One of the campers on Sandy Beach rode his ATC over to Ed Purlmutter's Casa and had them call Search and Rescue on the radio. By the time Search and Rescue members arrived at Sandy Beach the missing person was found safe but very cold, wet and tired.

Sunday evening with the sun setting fast and night coming on, we had one boat that had not come in. We were unable to make any radio contact with him, either on VFH or CB. Search and Rescue members were called to the Radio Shack. Since there was one man alone on the missing boat, a search was started. Two boats were launched, Martine Taylor and Bub Allison with their crews started the search. Bub Allison with his fantastic navigation system lead them out on a 240 degree heading toward 12 miles. But as they were searching at 12 miles, the missing boat was finally contacted on VHF radio. He said that he could see one red light and wanted to know how to lineup the lights on the tower of the Radio Shack. He was instructed. The search boats were recalled.

All three boats returned safely.


Both radios on the missing boat were just out the repair shop and neither worked properly.

This brings into focus the need to check all of your RADIO and SAFETY equipment every time you prepare to go out on the water.

Early Monday afternoon, a boat called Cholla Radio stating that he was at the Sand Dunes and couldn't get his motor started. This boat was a floating parts store--everything we asked him to check--he replaced. Distributor cap, rotor, condenser, points and carburetor. Over the radio, Fred Boyer and Butch Wilda were able to instruct him on what to check next and he finally was able to get the motor started and come in on his own power.

This report covers the weekend and I would like to thank Bub Allison, Martine Taylor and all the members of Search & Rescue for all of their help.

Jim found an older Dodge with the right price tag and went to work on it. He rebuilt the engine and replaced the transmission. The suspension also got Jim's touch as it would have to handle rough roads. After he got the engine running, he went to work on the body and interior, and outfitted the Dodge with emergency equipment.

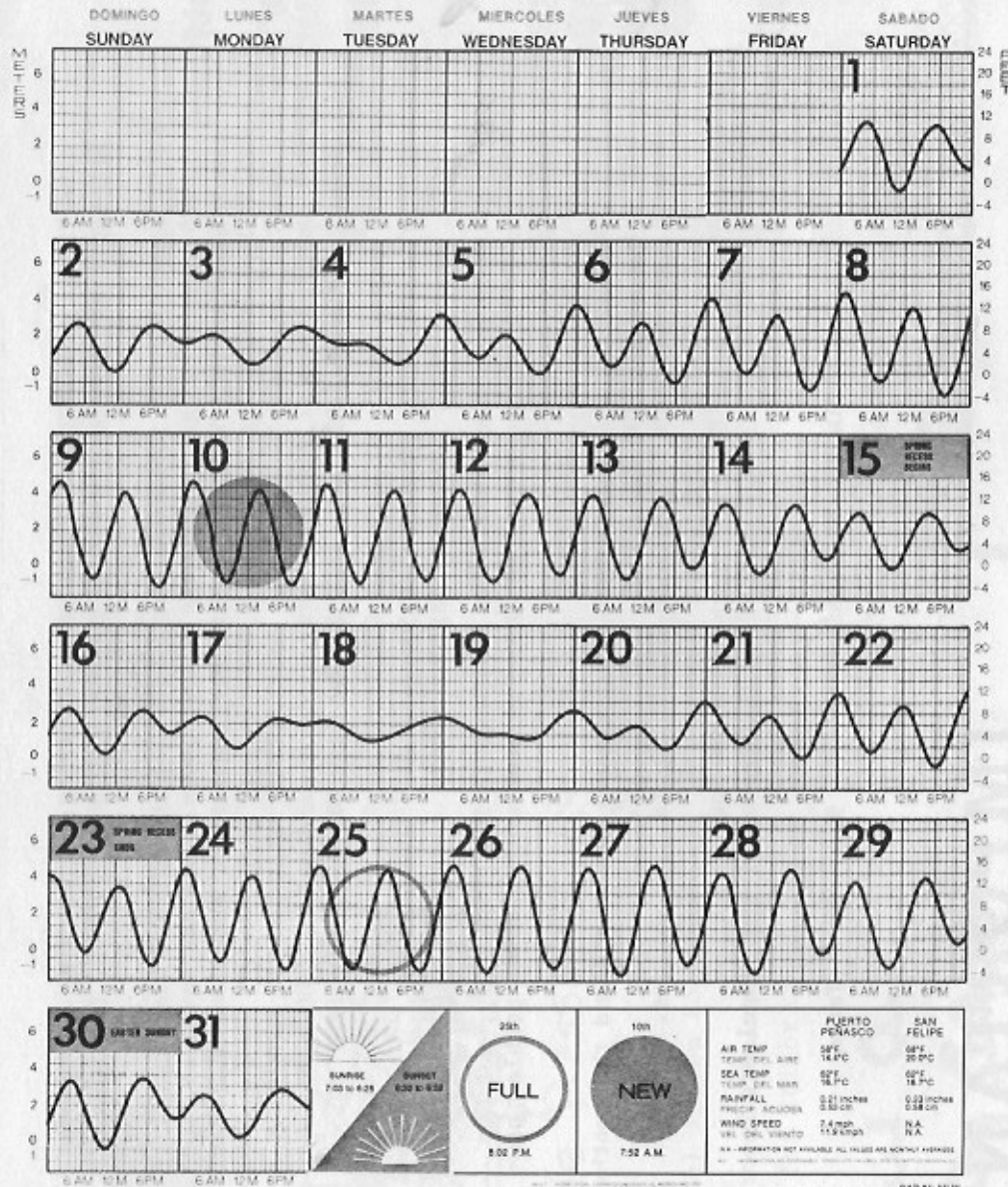
