¿QUE PASA AT BARRACHO FLATS?

Our Search and Rescue Team showed their true colors again, not too long ago. This time was to answer a "MAYDAY" distress call. the story goes as follows:

The Captain of the Port in Puerto Penasco called Augustin and asked if anyone in Cholla Bay could assist in locating and helping a "Mayday" call from a boat that was 12 to 14 miles southwest of Bird Island and was sinking with 10 people aboard. Augustin relayed the message on Channel 3 and immediately Martine answered the call. Warren Rames(Dolly M), who happened to be at the Radio Shack, went along as his crew member. Later Rojo with Cualio, his helper at the boat yard was put in the water followed by Skip Melcher with Tom Melcher and Marcelo Salazar as crew members. Martine had a good half hour head start so he was directed to stop off at Penasco and pick up two bilge pumps and hoses from a ponga boat who came out to meet him. When Martine finally located the boat in distress, the crew had already abandoned it and were in a life raft. The bow of the vessel was almost underwater and the stern couldn't hold out much longer. This boat was a 65 foot tuna training vessel, built in Seattle, Washington. As soon as Martine pulled alongside of the boat, Warren jumped aboard and put one of the bilge pump hoses into the hold while Martine tried to start the pump. They had to switch to the other pump as the first one was out of gas. Martine didn't have any spare gas with him and had to keep draining his carburator line to maintain the pump. The other two boats had spare gas and this relieved the situation. It took about 45 minutes for the sinking boat to start raising. Much later, when the boat was ready to be towed by a shrimper who had shown up earlier and was standing by, hooked on to the crippled boat, Martine then hooked on to the boat and Rojo hooked on to Martine and hours later finally arrived back in Penasco.

A footnote to this rescue - all but two crew members of the distressed boat and Warren rode back with it. The rest rode back on the Shrimp boat. Martine's boat received extensive damage while tied to the boat. Among other things, the upper port side was cracked, damage to the hatch and spotlight. As for Warren Rames, Martine told me later that he didn't realize till much later just how dangerous it was for Warren to jump onto the

sinking boat.

Thanks again fellows for another job well done. I know everyone in Cholla feels safer with you guys around.

SEARCH & RESCUE

CHOLLA BAY RADIO OPERATIONS

The radios operated by the Cholla Bay Sportsmen's Club are essential to providing for effective communication and boating safety in the Puerto Penasco area. It is important that the radios be operated in a manner which meets the needs of our users. Frequently, especially on busy weekends, conversation on our primary frequencies is so heavy as to jeopardize their effective use for handling normal boating operations and ensure safety needs are met.

In the event of an emergency when time is of the essence, the radio is often the only way to "sound the alarm" and obtain needed help. For this reason we ask that you monitor our safety and calling frequencies and use them to make initial contact with your party, then unless your conversation is with Cholla Radio, SWITCH TO ANOTHER CHANNEL FOR CONVERSATION!

Listed below are the channels in use by Cholla Radio:

<u>RADIO TYPE</u>	<u>SAFETY, CALLING & EMERGENCY CHANNELS</u>
CB	3 & 9
VHF Marine	16 & 26
AM Marine	2182

You will note that the safety and calling channels are AM Marine 2182, VHF Marine 16 & 26, and CB channel 3. As in the United States, CB channel 9 is for emergency use and should be used for that purpose only. Channel 9 is monitored by both Cholla Radio and the Mexican agencies.



REMEMBER, it is important that our safety and calling channels remain as clear as possible if we are to handle normal traffic and emergencies effectively. After making your initial contact on a safety and calling channel, switch to another channel for conversation with other than Cholla Radio.

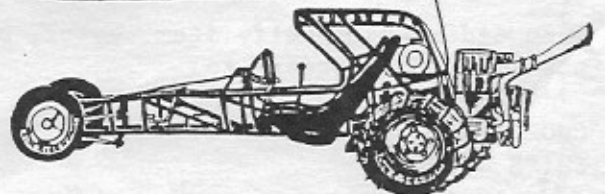

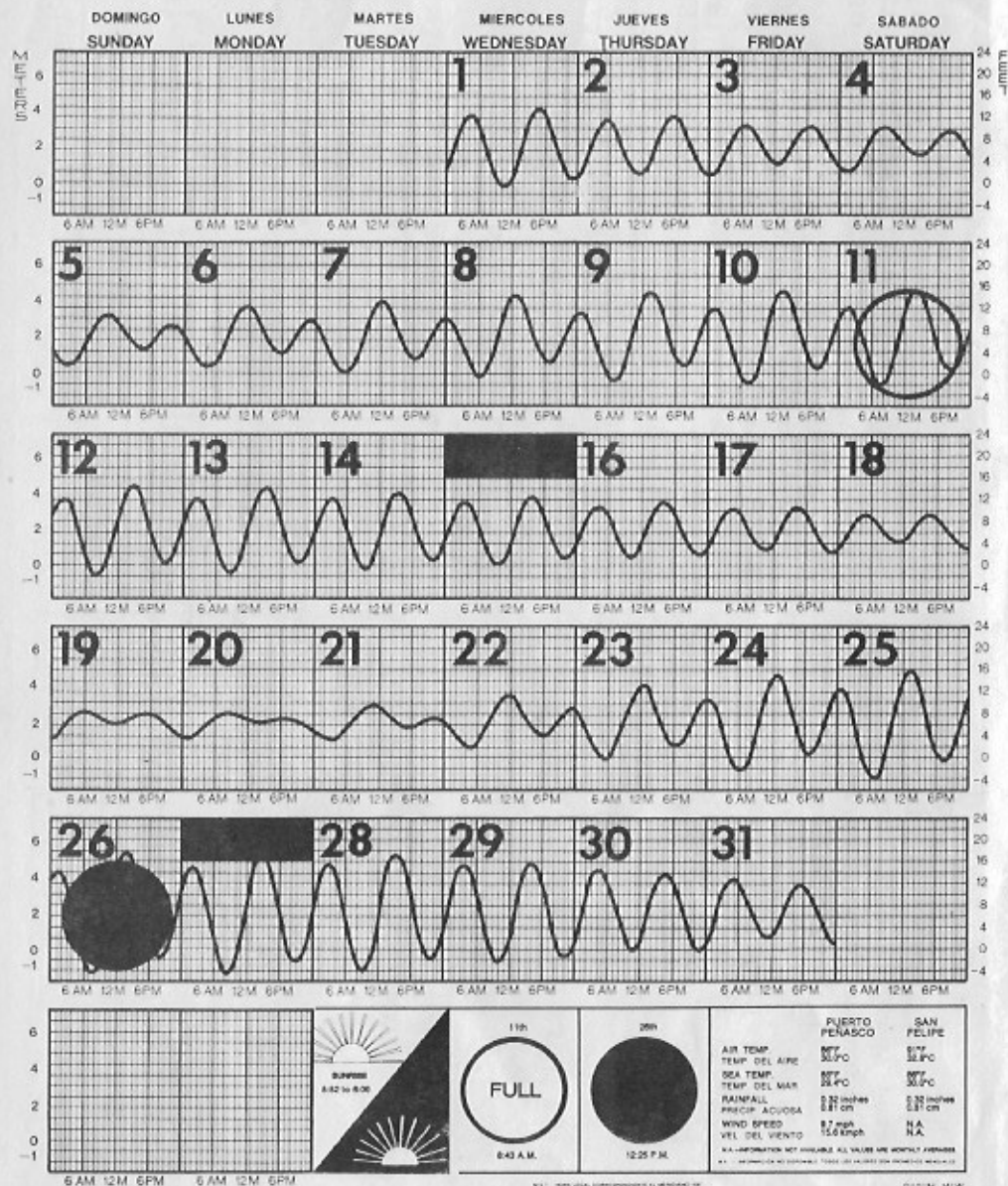
