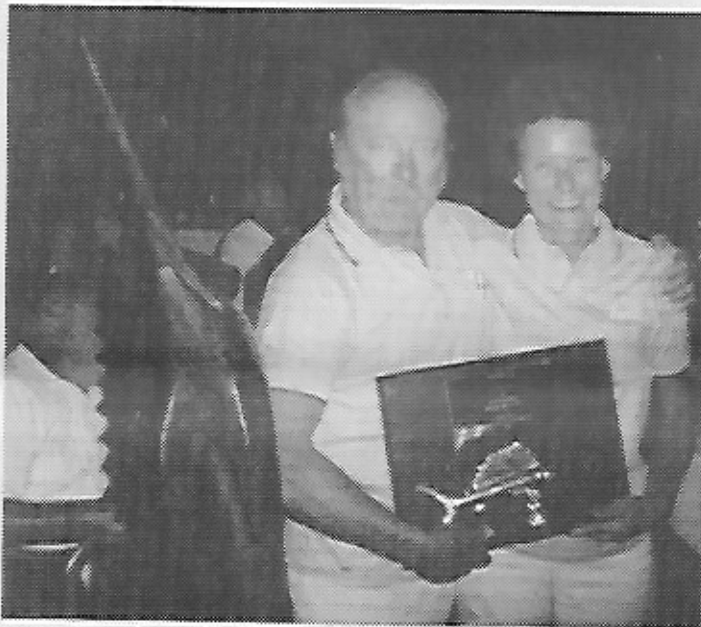


Maggie Ennis with Grand Trophy.

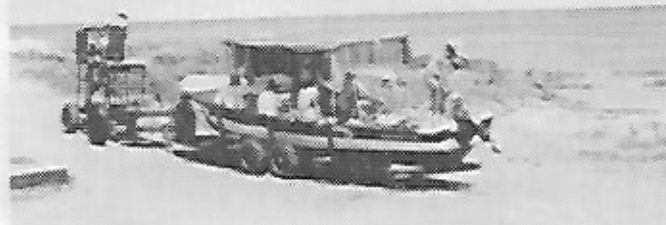

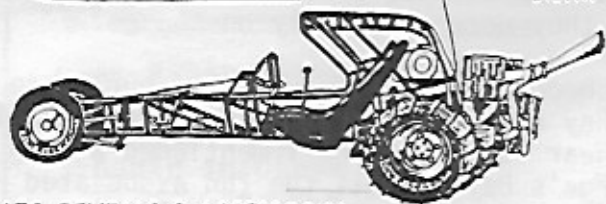

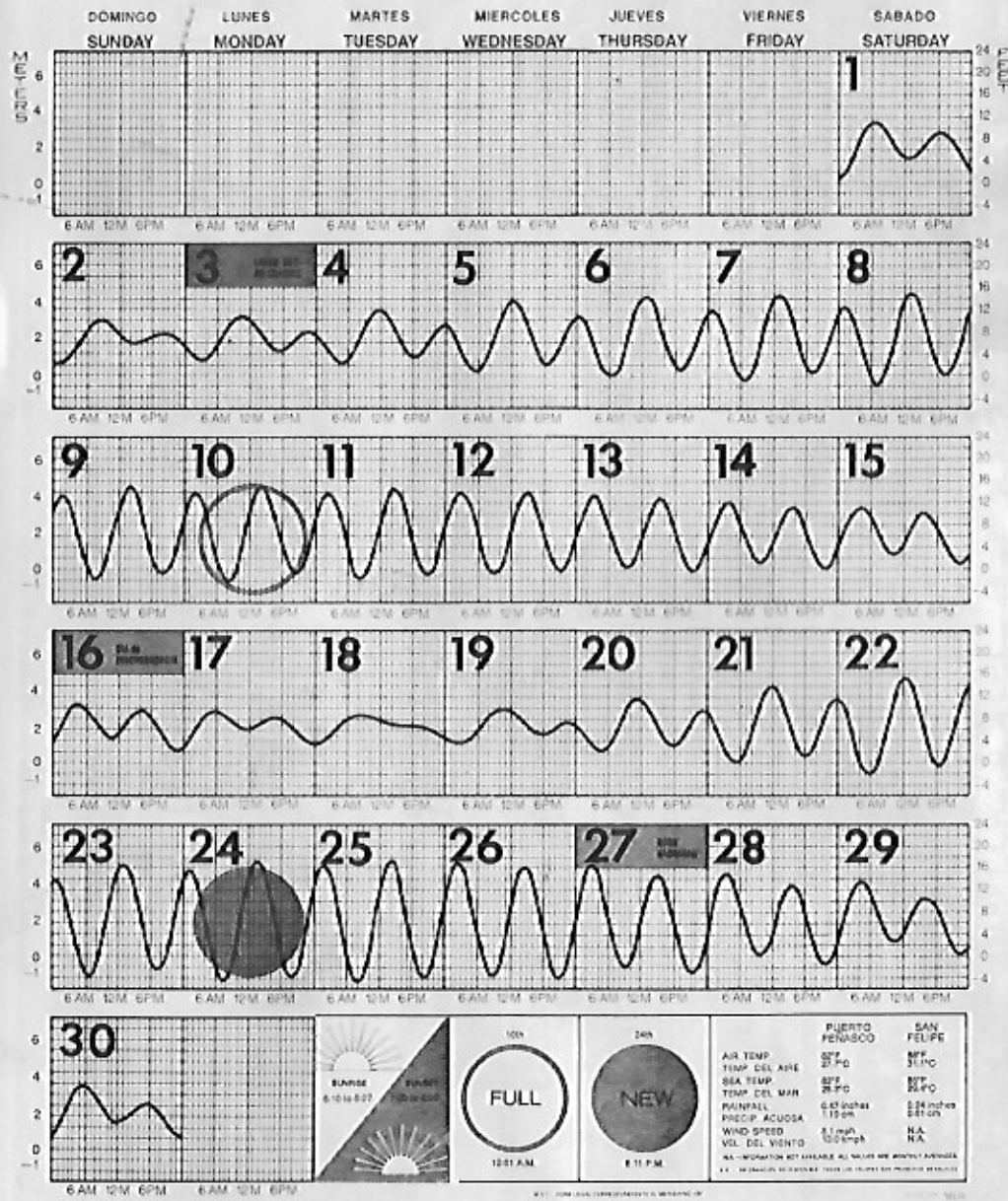
