Toiletries - toilet paper, toothbrushes, toothpaste, soap, shampoo.

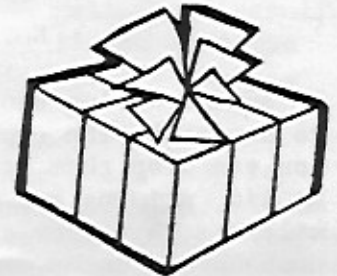
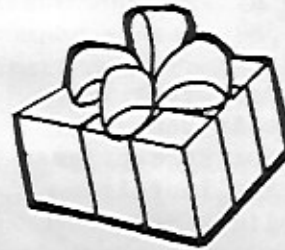
