Agustin is probably the best known resident of Cholla Bay, he is in demand twenty-four hours a day and is always ready to lend a helping hand.



A special thanks is in order to Agustin also, for going above and beyond the call of duty for all of Cholla Bay. Thanks Agustin for doing a great job.






Agustin Leon ready and waiting for Cholla Bay residents calls on the radios at the radio room. Note the Cholla Chatter, dated March of 1961.


Chuck Payne made a motion that a beam be purchased in memory of Canhardly, it was seconded by Lee Cashion. Numerous door prizes were won.

Dear Clubmembers,



Her visits took her over a wide area of Cholla Bay. She was well known for the friendliness and kindly attitude toward the Bay's children.




#### HELPING HANDICAPPED CHILDREN





Thanks to all that donated the many wonderful door prizes for which drawings were held.






#### LIVE BAIT RIGS FOR LAZY GROUPER


One consideration given major importance by bottom fishermen using live bait such as sardines, mackeral, rock bass, or anchovies is the amount of movement the bait has, (it's ability to draw strikes) and how its movement may be restricted by the way the bait is rigged. A traditional terminal rig for fishing at or near the bottom with live baits consists of a dropper loop tied into the main line at about 2 feet up the line from a torpedo sinker. An O'Shaugnessy style live bait hook is run up the line prior to tying the dropper loop and it is left to move freely inside the finished loop, giving the bait a few inches ( up to 10" or 12") with heavier gear of free movement around the main line. This is especially good rigging to use with live crabs on the hook as any erratic behavior on the part of the bait stimulates the fish into a strike action. Also shown by diagram here are rechniques for hooking some of our "strange" baits.




Technique for hooking shore crabs.




