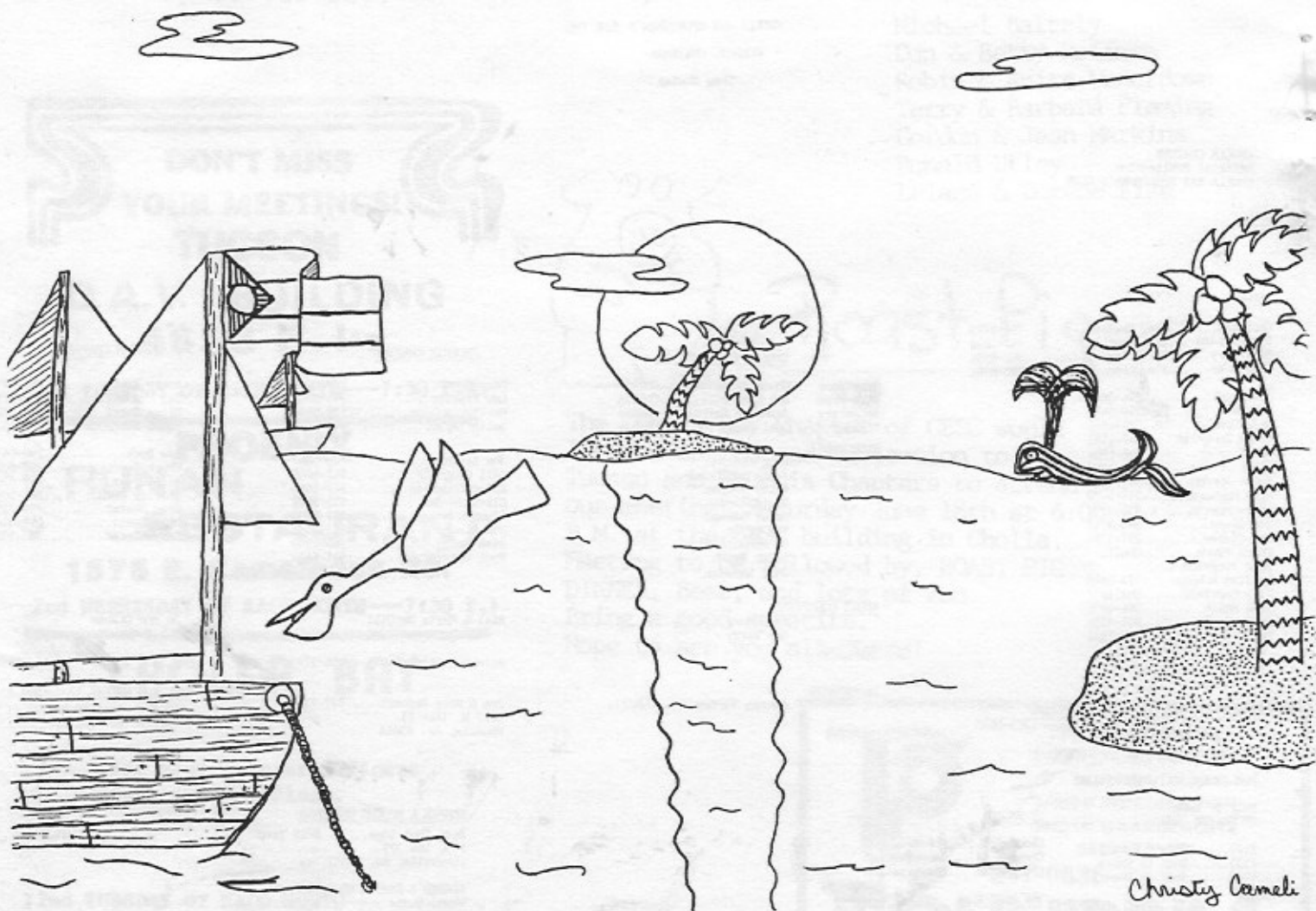

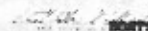

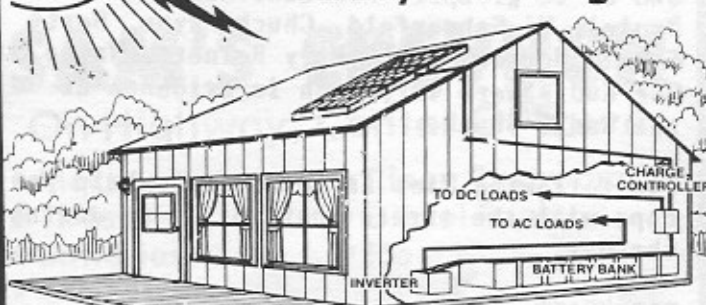

### RULES FOR THIS DIET

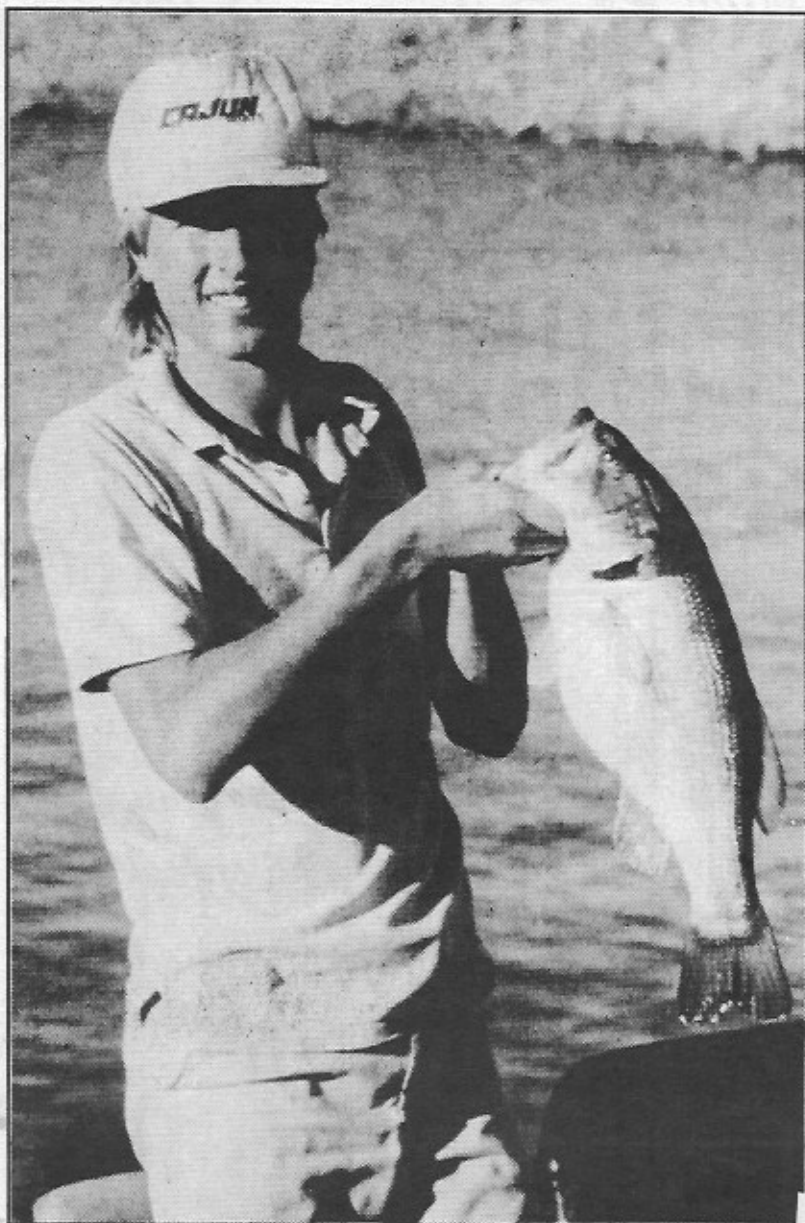

## Bass • Quail • Trout • Letters



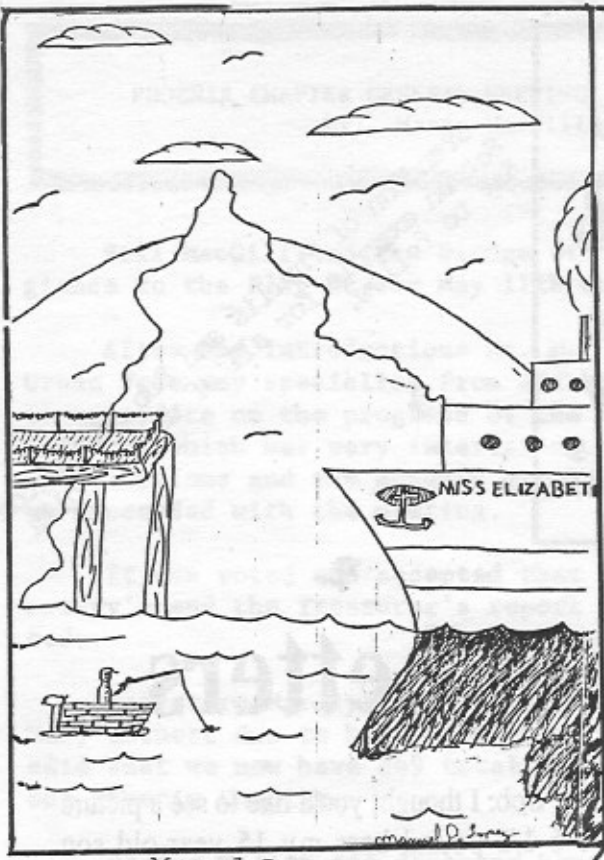

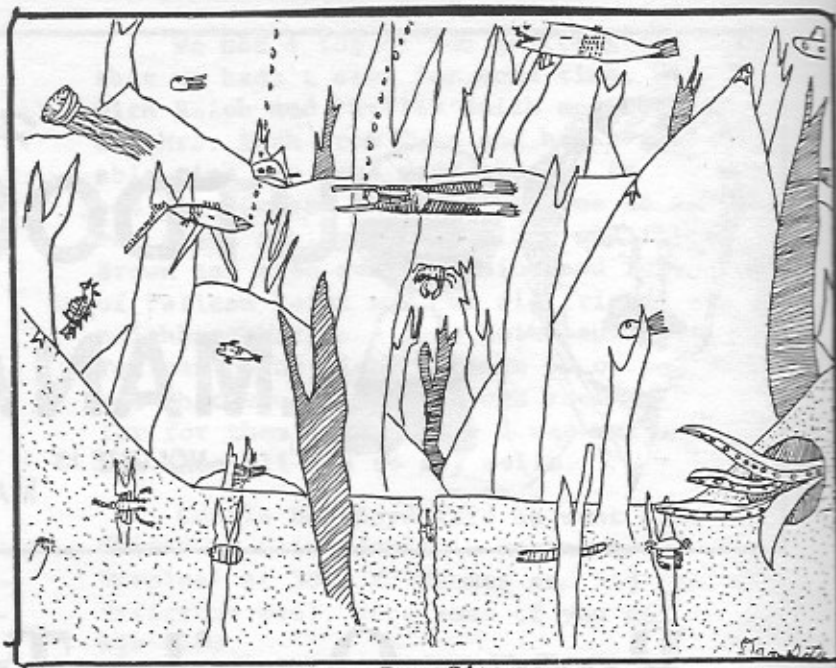
Now, whenever I think of that big bass cruising the shoreline in search of a meal, I get a good feeling. A feeling that the future of our fish and wildlife is in good hands.
