The telephone was ringing as I stepped through the front door.



But they refused to give me two nickles for my dime.







I have gone to many places and really had my day,



Harry & Hilga Mottek were down for a few days this month at the Estero Morua and were just beyond theirselves at how nice the weather was at this time of the year.



They were having COON-DOG try out trials just down the road from us. The dogs could be heard in the early mornings and late evenings.






