"It's so hot the chickens are laying eggs on the run 'cause it's too hot to squat."

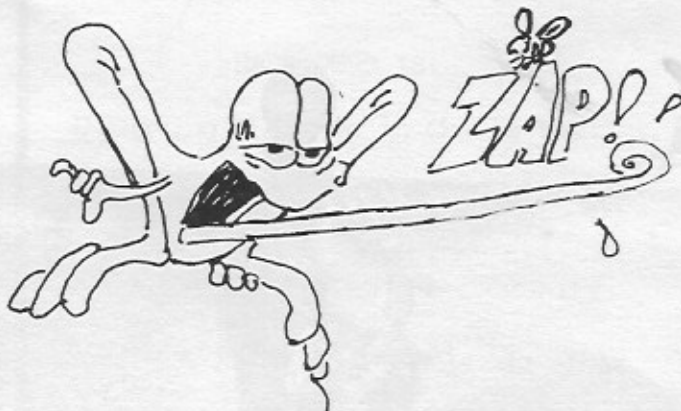
"Wait a minute," I said. "I've already had one bad chicken joke."

"Hello?"

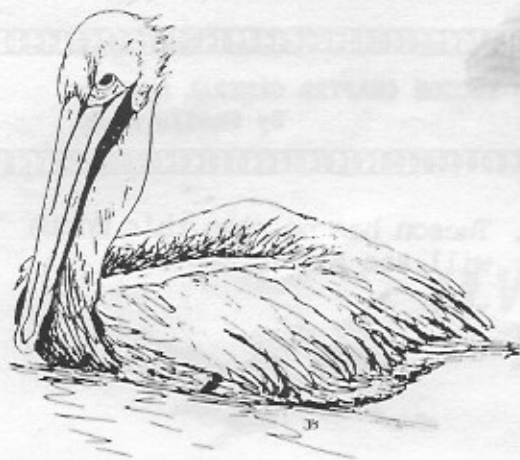

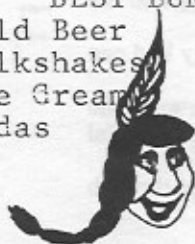

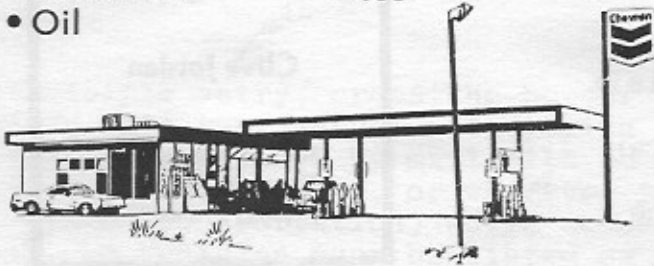

 But they refused to give me two nickles for my dime.



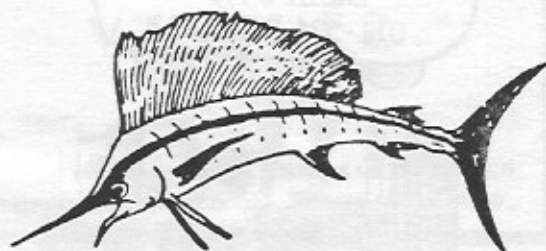

John and Dorothy Hurst are just now getting snugged into their new home at Playa Encanto. I feel sure we will be seeing lots of them at out meetings in Cholla now.

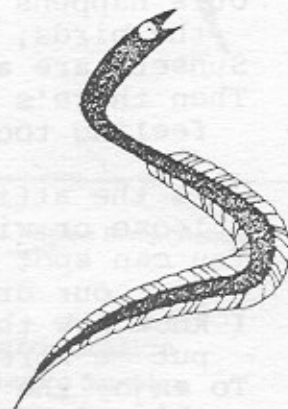
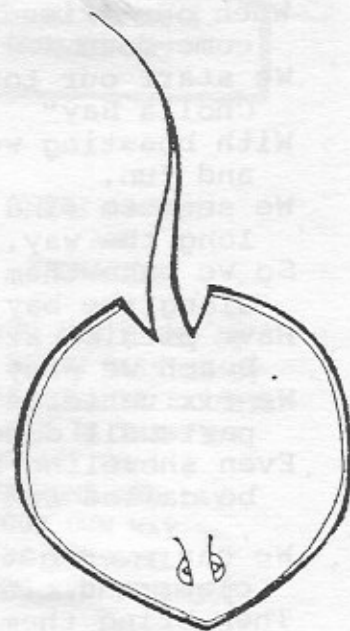
Harry & Hilga Mottek were down for a few days this month at the Estero Morua and were just beyond theirselves at how nice the weather was at this time of the year.

They were having COON-DOG try out trials just down the road from us. The dogs could be heard in the early mornings and late evenings.

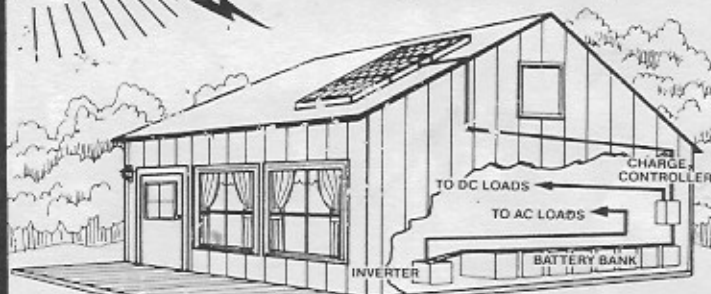

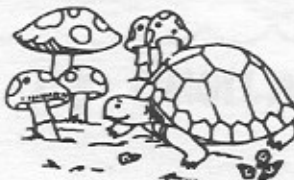

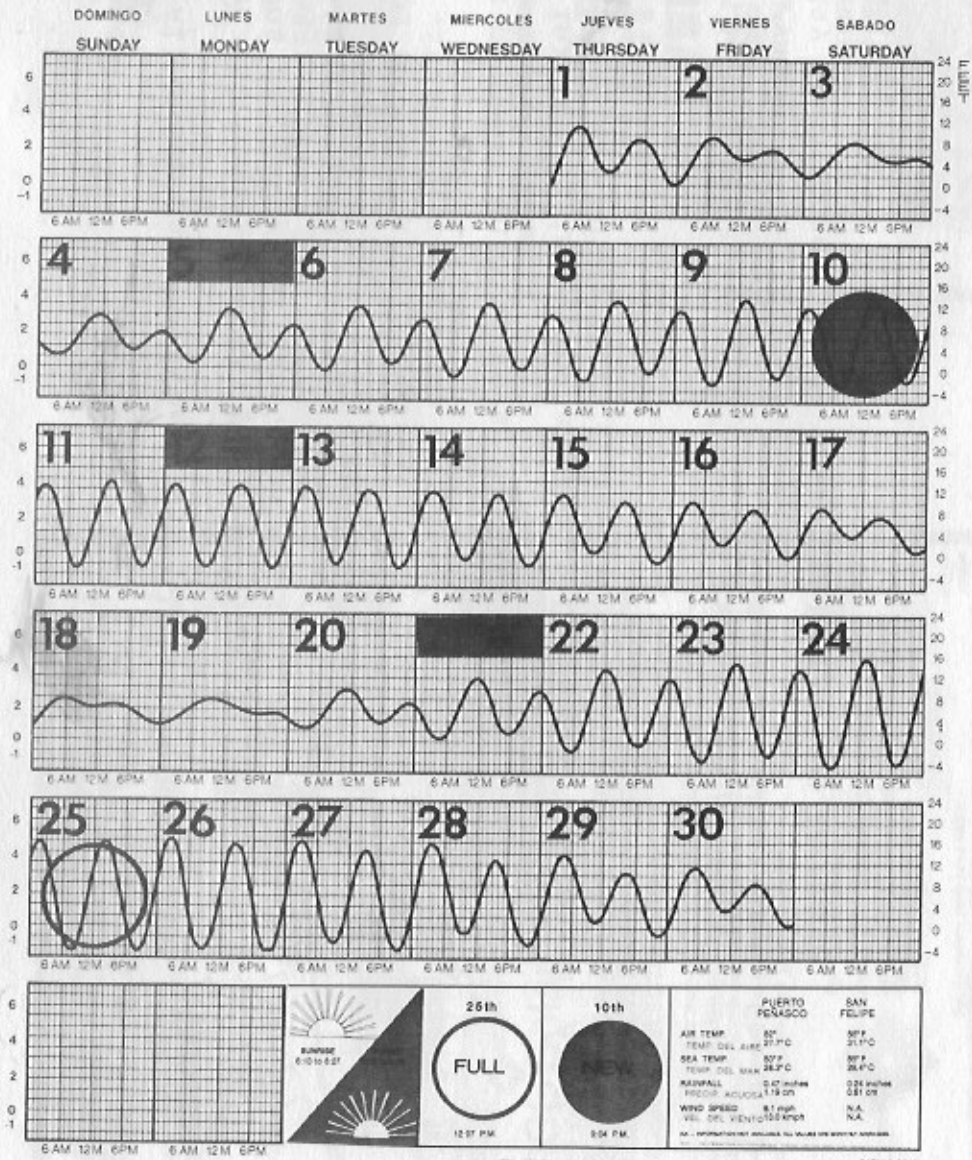
