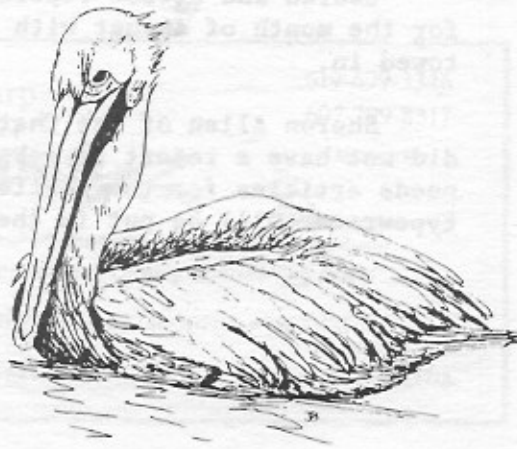
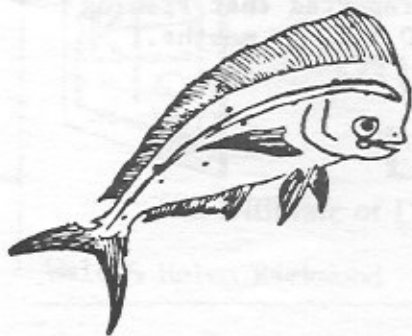
Adrian has been appointed by the city of Puerto Penasco to serve as officer in charge of law enforcement in Cholla Bay.

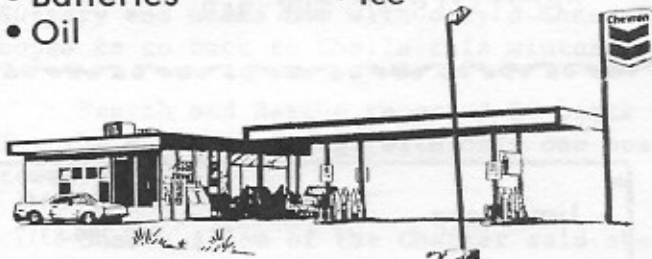
Joe Reinert fell and injured a leg. It has healed and Joe is back to his salubrious self.
