The past two weekends-Halloween & the 5th of Nov. 88 the magnet of Mexico drew us to our beautiful Sea of Cortez ... Down we came to Cholla Bay Sonora to cabin # 403 Sunworshipper Thursday night the Acapulco Bay Beach Club could be Halloween weekend. We had anticipation of lots of fish and maybe and overnight at San Jorge Bay in the boat. No work, just play! Fishing Fishing-scales guts crabs and good eating! I had a new toy too a B.B. Q. grill for the boat that we planned to B.B.Q. fresh Sierra on--our favorite seafood

Anyhow we launched Saturday after working all day Friday repacing the whole outdrive that had just been repaired. We sat our heading for 22 mile reef as we had heard the fish were there!

fished joyfully for 2 hours with sore arms, fingers 4 Pargo, 2 Pinto and a zillion Trigger fish. It was almost like the " old days" each time we wetted a line we got one! I wonder if called trigger happy? We pulled the whole outdrive off the Sunworshipper Sunday and Headed home to Phoenix.

SANDCAST CANDLES

First, get all your items together such as box, sand, parafine, crayons to color your parafine, wick and your mold. Dampen the sand in the box, then press your mold into the sand until it is nice and firm. Remove the mold and set your wick. Pour the parafine which has been melted and colored into the mold. When the parafine sets, push the sand away and remove from the sand. Now brush the loose sand from the candle with a soft paint brush and spray with plastic or varnish spray.

You can use your last years candles and proceed in the same manner. It's a lot of fun to experiment with different forms and colors. Also, one can scent the candles with pine oil. Only one word caution. Parafine gets very hot so be careful when you are melting and pouring.






