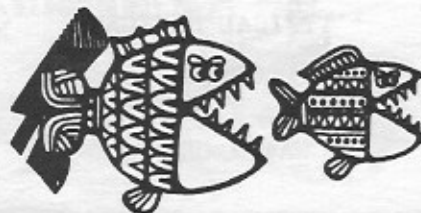

**Radio Procedures—
A primer on the proper
use of your transmitter**

DISTRESS CALLS—Mayday calls must pertain solely to life and death situations, or when grave and imminent danger threatens your boat, such as fire or sinking, and immediate help is required. Mayday should not be used for situations such as being out of fuel, running aground, or engine failure. Select VHF Channel 16 or SSB frequency 2182 kHz for a distress call. Speak slowly and clearly, "Mayday, Mayday, Mayday, this is (your vessel's call letters and name repeated three times)." After identifying yourself, say where you are and what is wrong.

URGENT SIGNALS—These are the second-highest priority radio transmissions. A vessel overdue and presumed in trouble may warrant an

urgent signal. Say the words, "Pan Pan Pan" (rhymes with *dawn*) and then send your message concerning your need for non-immediate assistance, such as towing service for a disabled vessel.

SAFETY SIGNALS—If you spot an obvious hazard, such as a large submerged object in a shipping lane, use the phrase, "Securite Securite Securite" (pronounced *see-cure-ee-tay*), which indicates that you are about to transmit a message about navigation safety or a meteorological warning.

OTHER TIPS:

- Always listen at least 30 seconds before transmitting so as not to interfere with other transmissions
- Transmit on low power as often as possible with marine VHF. Use high power only if other stations indicate your signal is breaking up.

● Always use your official FCC call letters, and select proper channels for specific communications. You must choose a channel appropriate for the type of message you want to send.

● Leave your set tuned on VHF Channel 16, or marine SSB frequency 2182 kHz, whenever your set is turned on and not being used. FCC rules require relaying any distress messages heard. The FCC also requires that calls to other vessels be no longer than 30 seconds. Wait at least two minutes before calling again. After three calling periods, wait at least 15 minutes before calling again.

● Obscenity or profanity is prohibited by the FCC. Fines of more than \$10,000, or imprisonment for not more than two years, is possible for violators.

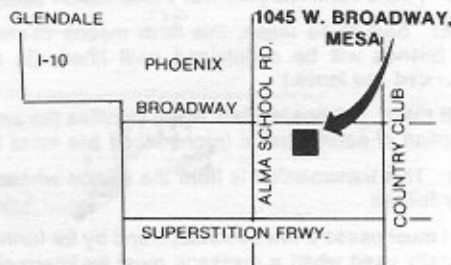

Proper Radiospeak

Use good operating techniques and procedural words. The following terms have been adopted by the Radio Technical Commission for marine radio use.

- AFFIRMATIVE:** You are correct, or what you have transmitted is correct.
- BREAK:** I separate the text from other portions of the message; or one message from one immediately following.
- FIGURES:** Figures or numbers follow. (Used when numbers occur in the middle of a message: "Vessel length is figures two-two-three-feet.")
- I SPELL:** I shall spell the next word phonetically. (Note: Often used where a proper name or unusual word is important to a message: "Boat name is *Martha*. I spell—Mike; Alfa, Romeo; Tango; Hotel; Alfa.")
- NEGATIVE:** No.
- OUT:** This is the end of my transmission to you and no answer is required or expected.
- OVER:** This is the end of my transmission to you and a response is necessary. Go ahead and transmit. (Note: Observe the considerable difference between OVER, used during a message exchange, and OUT, employed at the end of an exchange. OVER should be omitted when the context of a transmission makes it clear that it is unnecessary.)
- ROGER:** I have received your last transmission satisfactorily.
- SILENCE:** Said three times, this term means cease all transmissions immediately. Silence will be maintained until lifted. (In this meaning, SILENCE is pronounced *see lonss*.)
- SILENCE FINI:** Silence is lifted. Note: signifies the end of the emergency and the resumption of normal traffic (pronounced *see lonss fee nee*).
- THIS IS:** This transmission is from the station whose name or call sign immediately follows.
- WAIT:** I must pause a few seconds; stand by for further transmission. (Note: This is normally used when a message must be interrupted by the sender, such as when looking up information requested, or to suspend the transmission of an on-the-air test on a channel already in use.)

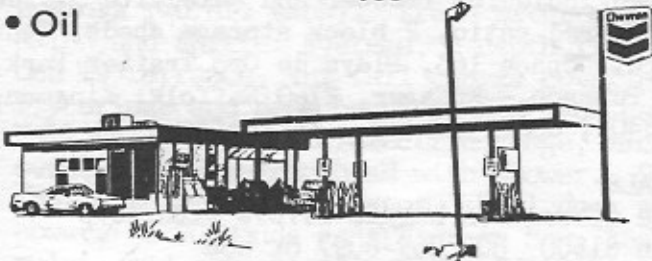

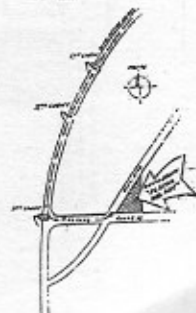

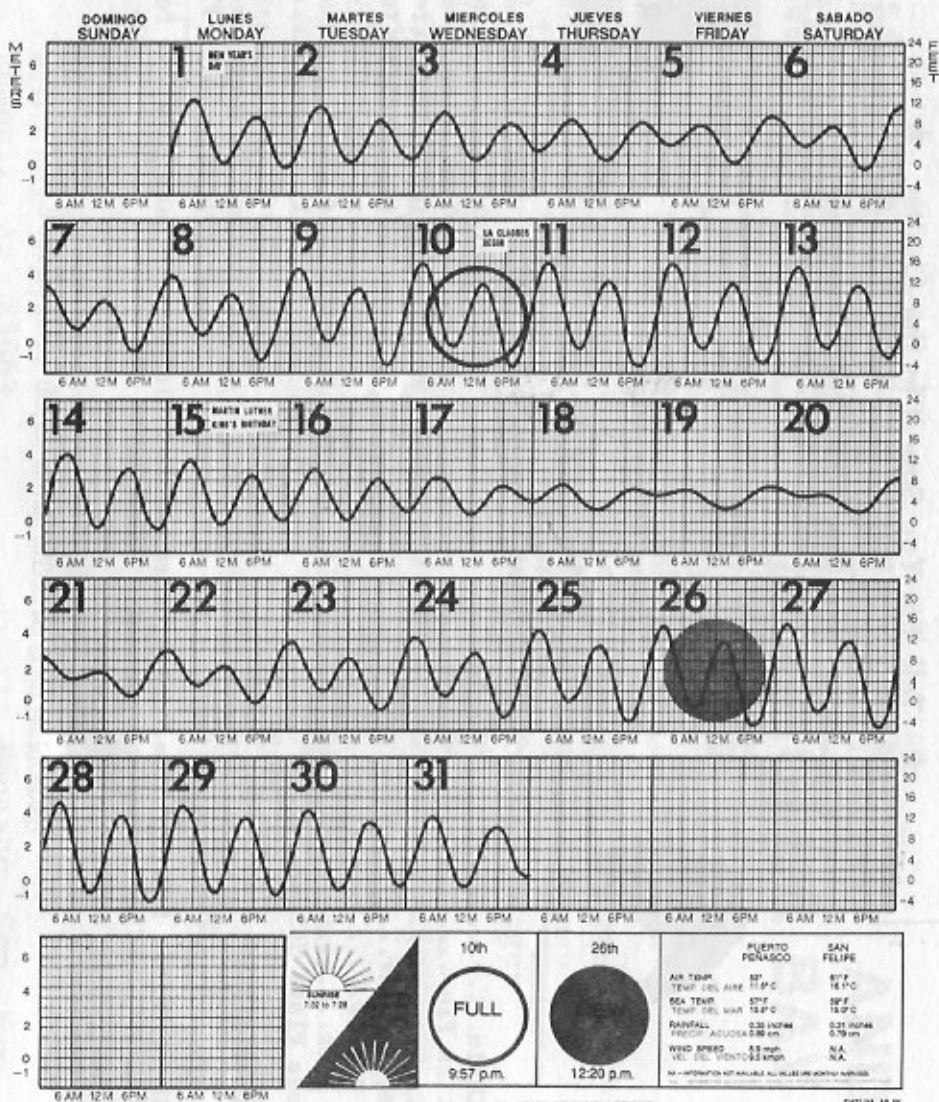
