

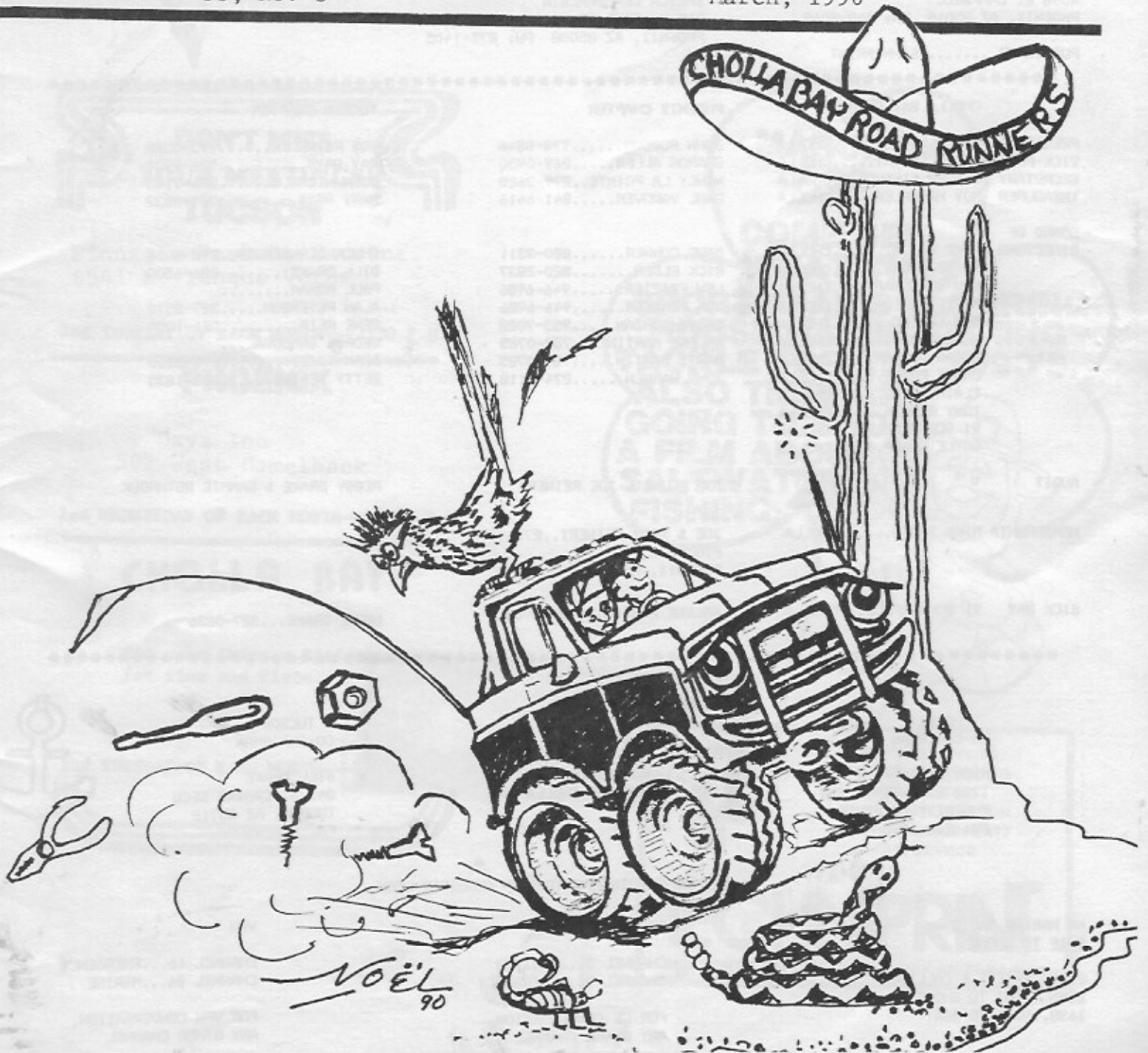

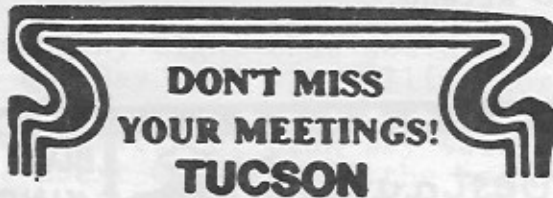

MEXICAN AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE
