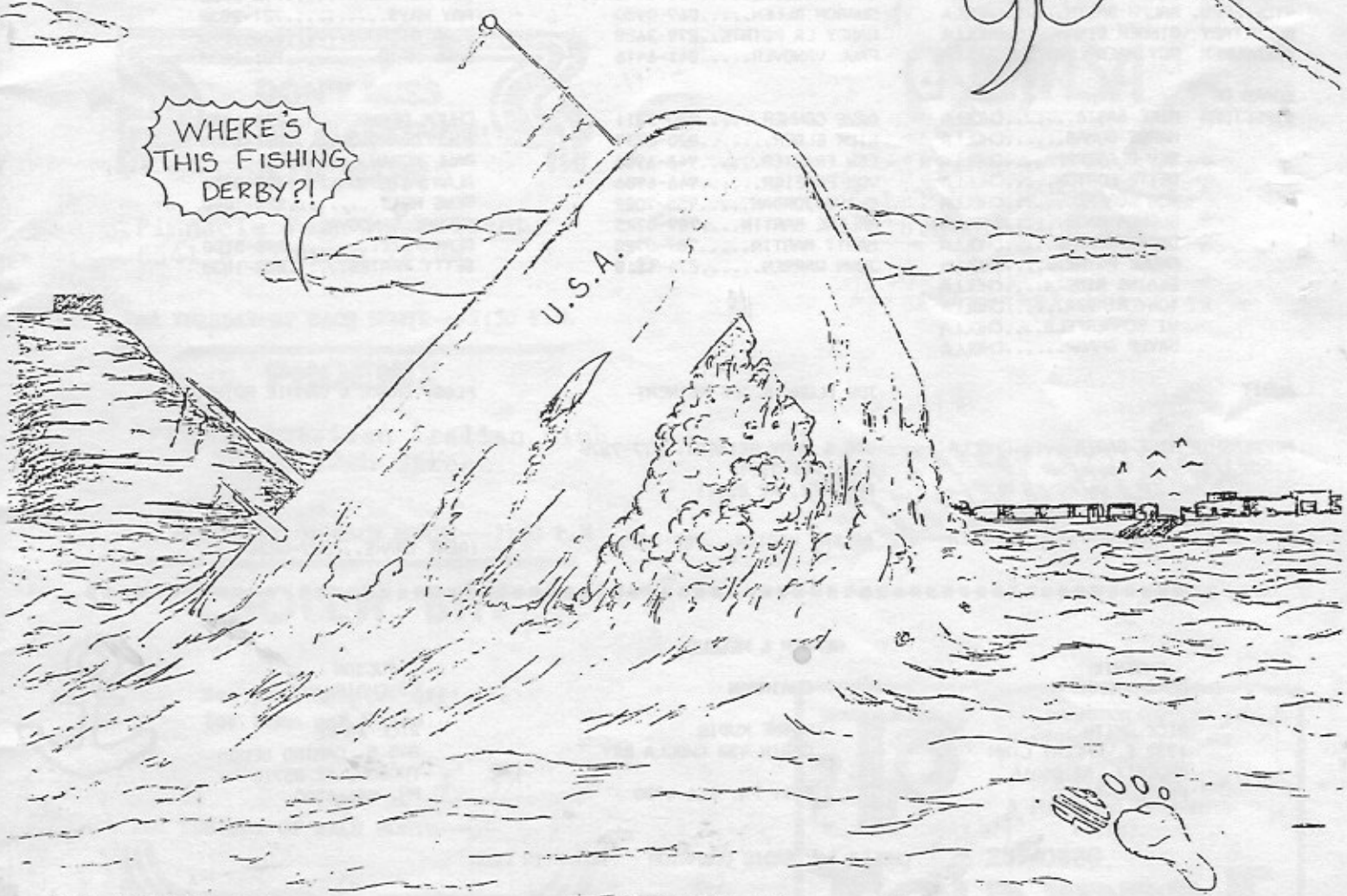



LIONEL VALENZUELA VASQUEZ

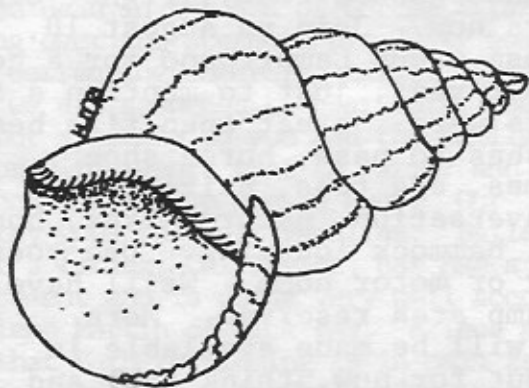
