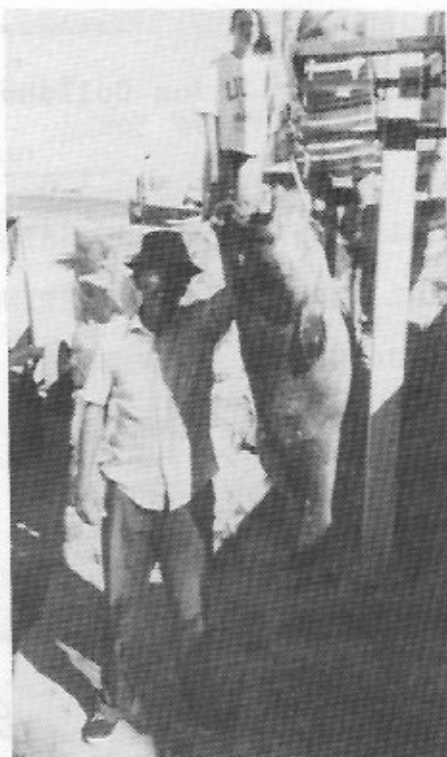

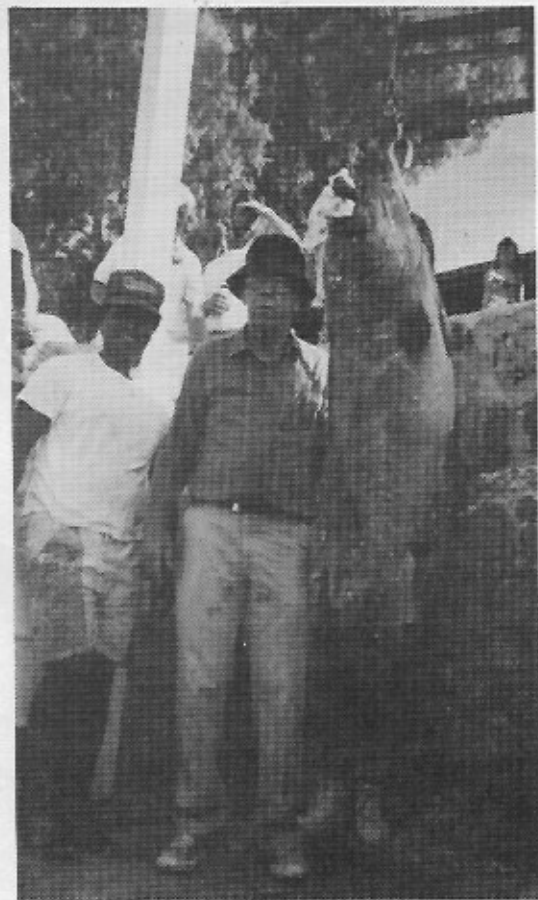

At 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 21st, eleven vehicles met at the Gus Brown Plaza and left on the trip. What an adventure!!

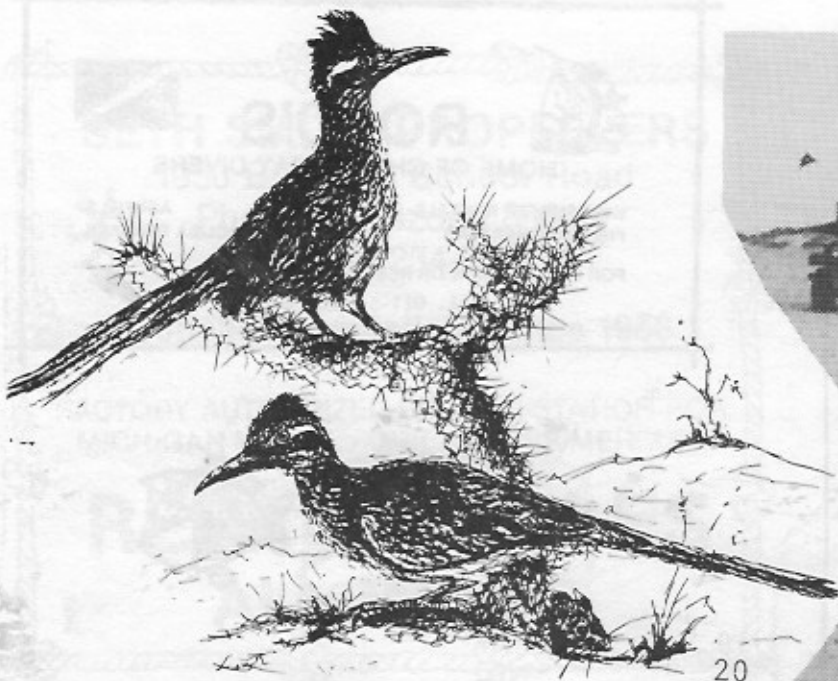
