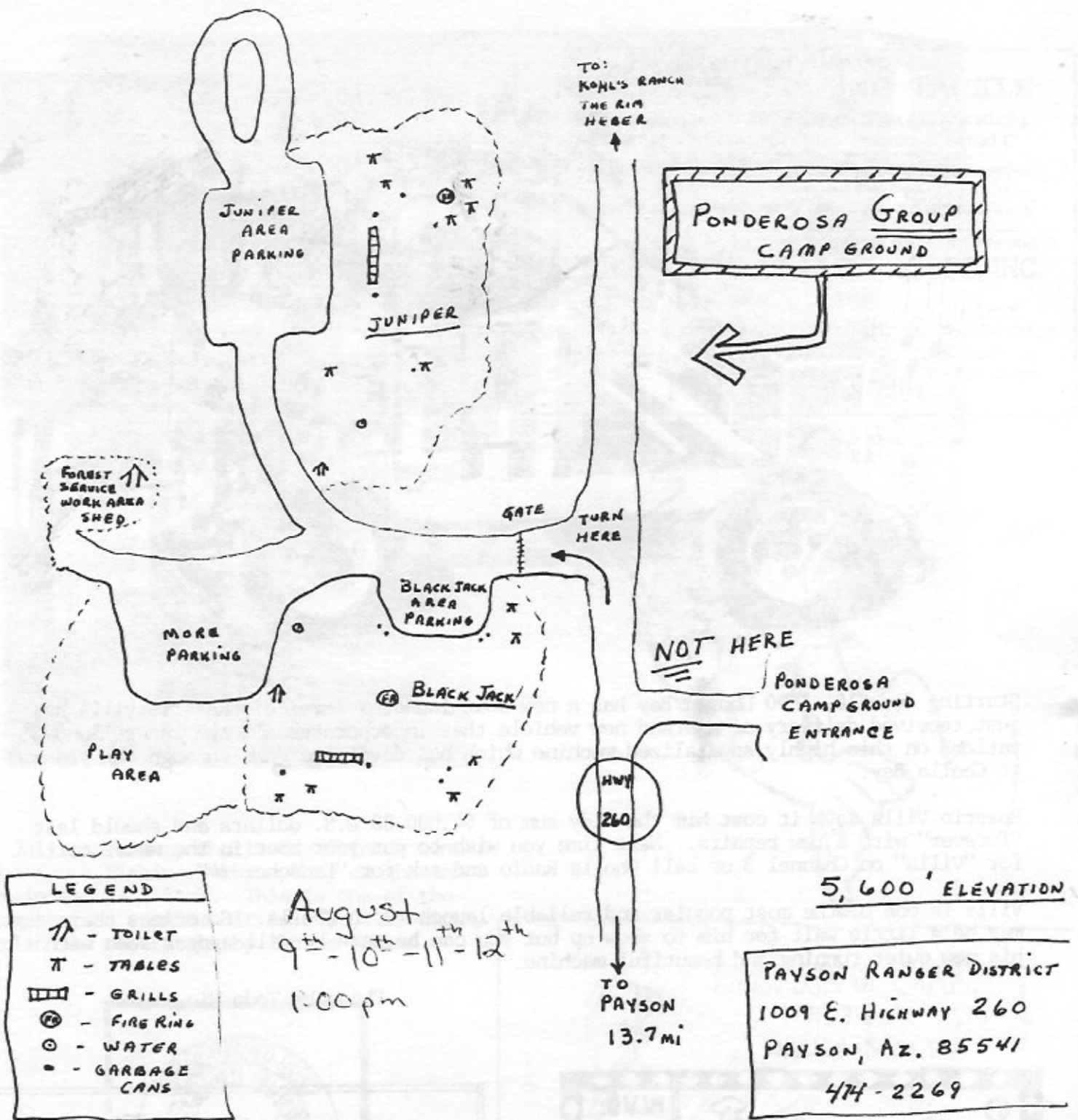

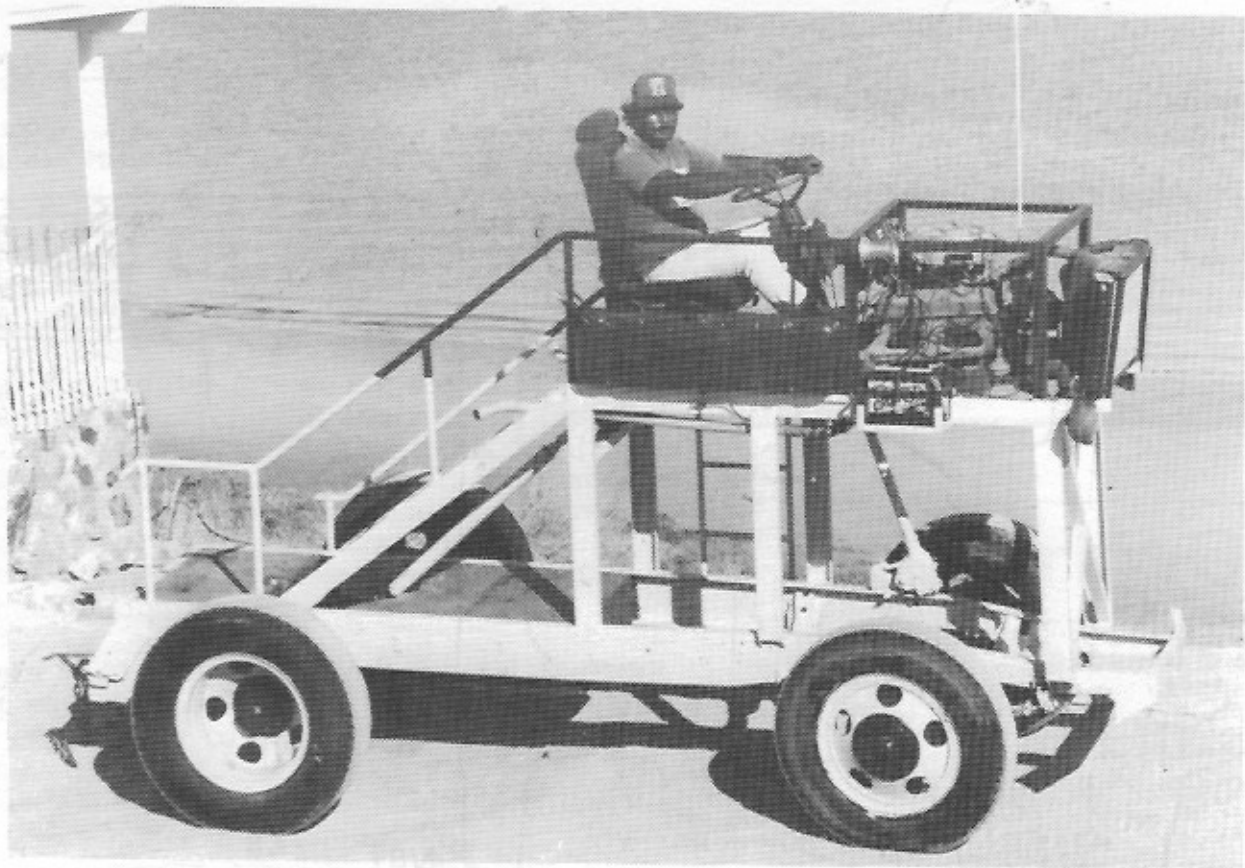


CHOLLA BAY SPORTSMAN'S CLUB SUMMER CAMPOUT

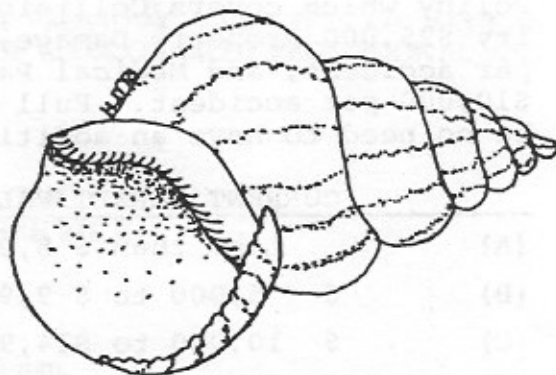

MEXICAN AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE

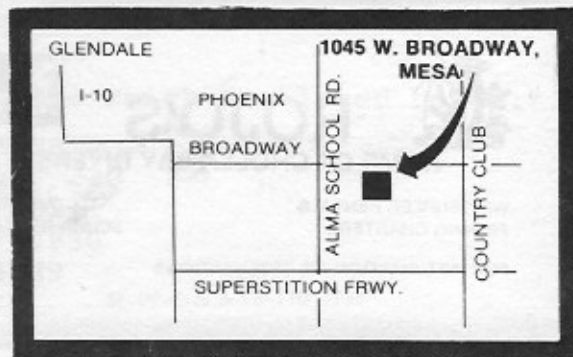

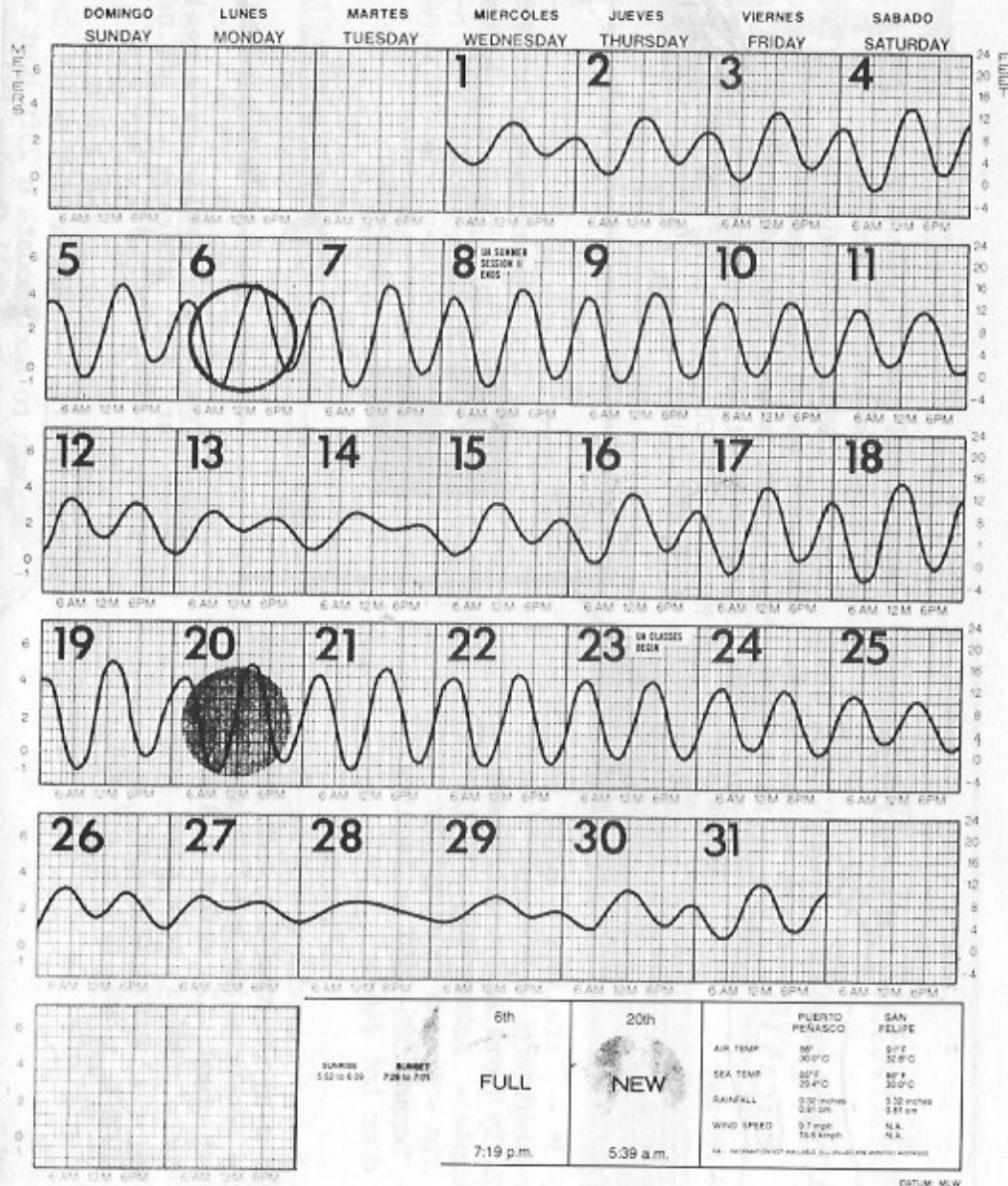
