



2000 FIESTA DE LA NAVIDAD—Cholla Bay Style

2000 marks our first Christmas celebration for our Mexican neighbors in Cholla Bay in the beautifully remodeled Fry Shack (Community Center). Everything about the celebration was delightful. Prior to the day of the party, the children of Cholla gathered at the Community Center for 3 consecutive Saturdays to practice the Christmas Carols, make props, drink hot chocolate and eat cookies and this year they baked cookies themselves to take to Casa Hogar (Old folks home). The cookies were colorful and tasted delicious.



At 11 am on Saturday, December 16, Reindeer, Xavier, pulled the sleigh carrying Santa (Sal Otanez and Mrs. Claus, Teresa Wilson) to the community center where the children cheered. Santa and Mrs. Claus went inside as the children sang verses to the traditional Las Posadas begging entrance, while invited to enter, the children lined up to have their pictures taken with Santa and Mrs. Claus. Santa's surroundings were festive with a magnificently adorned tree and lots of familiar Christmassy figures.

In Santa's workshop the children decorated frames for their pictures and made mobile Santa's. Then their tummies were treated to hot dogs, chips, cookies and punch.

Agustin, our able master of ceremonies, then announced that the children of Cholla would entertain with carols and dancing at which they did themselves proud. Our little choir grows bigger and better each year.

At last, piñata time! In the Gus Brown Plaza the children swung with all their might and those piñatas were a challenge to break but when the candy finally spilled out the fun began!

Meanwhile, Santa's sleigh was being packed with gifts for the children and trucks were filled with food boxes in which turkeys were the main attraction. When the party ended, Santa and his entourage, bells jingling, went from house to house to deliver the gifts and to wish all a happy holiday season. Families waited outside their homes and children squealed when the sleigh with Santa and Mrs. Claus waving came into view. Hugs, kisses and good feelings abounded. When the last child was hugged by Santa, the sleigh pulled away not to be seen again until Christmas 2001.

I think we can speak for all of you who had a hand in making the Christmas Party a reality for our Mexican neighbors in Cholla Bay when we say that it truly is a pleasure to be a part of. So many of you did so much. We were truly moved by you generosity. You contributed 56 turkeys. We used 37 of them for the families, 3 of them went to Casa Hogar, 3 of them will be used to



make soup to be distributed to a barrio of 400 families and the rest went to the Red Cross who will raffle them to their 74 volunteers. You brought and wrapped gifts for the children, contributed canned goods, peanut butter, mayonnaise, jelly, hot dogs, notebooks, pencils, crayons, candy, boxes for packing. You were there to pack the boxes, wrap the unwrapped gifts, make the frames for the pictures, help with the music, shop, assemble the mobile Santa, assist the children with their crafts, decorate the community center, take the pictures, fill and hang the piñatas, operate the sound system, cook and serve the hot dogs and punch, clean up, deliver the gifts, donate money. In short-you made it all possible. We, the lucky ones who are able to participate in the party and deliver the gifts to the homes, hear the myriad cries of "gracias" and receive the hugs and see the joy. But you are the ones who make it possible.
