

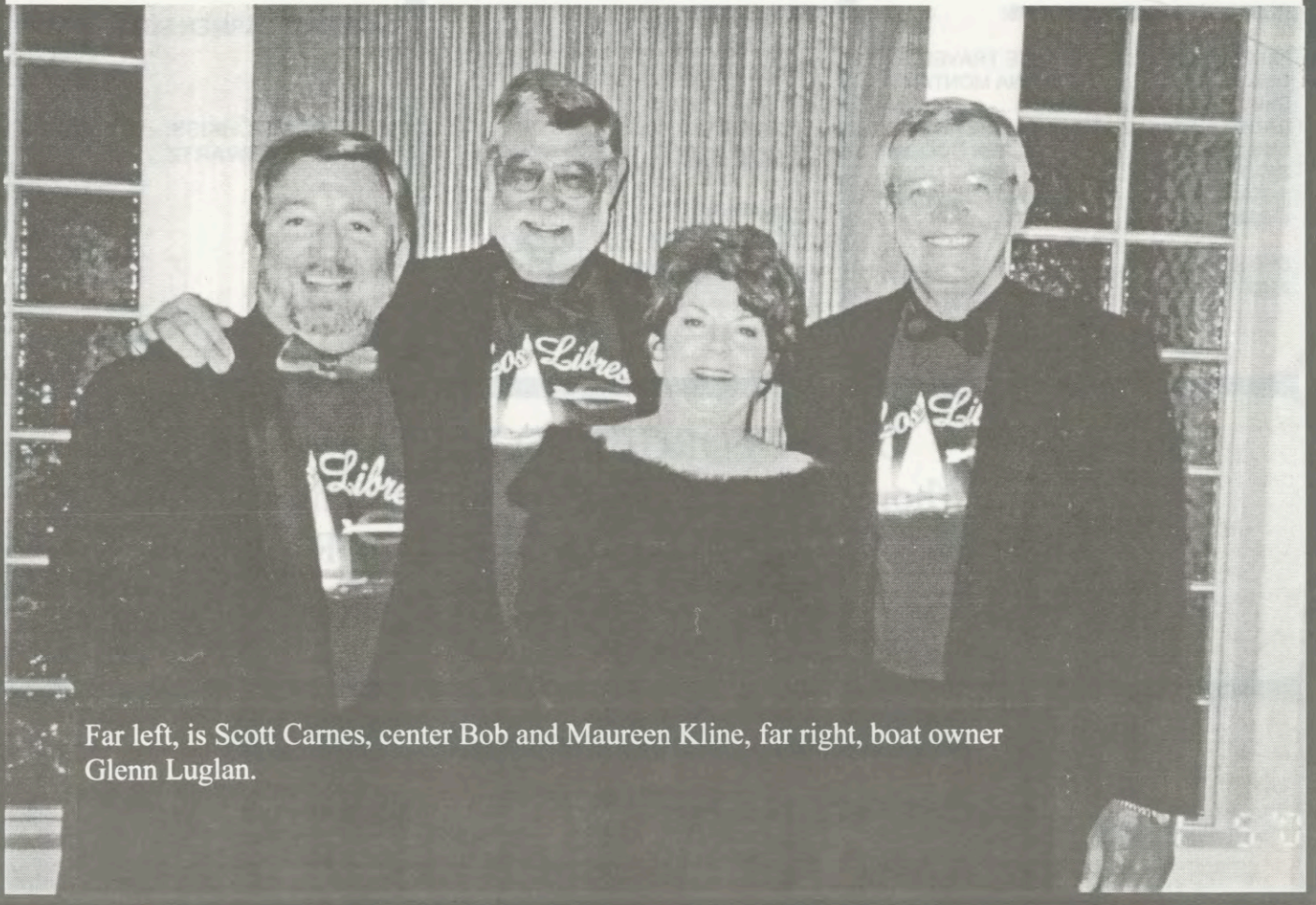

DATE: First one February 13, 2002, others to be held in March, April and possibly in May if needed. Those dates to be announced.

TIME: 2:00 P.M.

At our November CBSC monthly dinner meeting...Bob Belk spoke about the increased amount concerns that many of us were expressing to him regarding..."What to do in case of an emergency" and he very generously responded to those concerns with an offer to teach CPR classes...We are happy to announce...that the reaction to the classes were EXCELLENT and we are moving forward.

All of us know we need to be better prepared for an emergency because we do NOT have access to a 911 number here in Cholla...but did you know that we DO have access to the Red Cross ambulance service with an EMT on board...this precious time saving information. Plus much more is included into the CPR program.

Bob has created an incredible CPR program that has been broken down into 3 or 4 classes to be held in February, March, April and possible in May if need. Each class will be 30-45 minutes in length...and have been designed to build one class upon the other. Providing us with a "Complete Basic CPR Program".

THE PROGRAM WILL INCLUDE:

1. What signs to look for
2. When and where NOT to give CPR
3. What to DO
4. What equipment and supplies are available
5. Who to call
6. Where to go
7. Some preventative techniques
8. To have fun along with being well informed

Diane Bennett has devoted a lot of time researching information through the Heart Association and will be providing our class with valuable resource information and literature.

A great big thanks goes to Bob from all of us...for devoting his time and knowledge to the CPR project.

PROPOSED CHANGE TO CONTITION AND BY-LAWS
OF THE CHOLLA BAY SPORTSMAN'S CLUB

The Cholla Bay Sportsman's Club Council proposes the following changes to the Constitution and By-Laws. In a separate article of this issue of the Cholla Chatter you will find more information regarding this issue, and the reasons for needing the change.

Number 1: Change:

ARTICLE V - Section 2: (A)

From: All memberships in the Cholla Bay Sportsman's Club shall be Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) per calendar year.

To: All memberships in the Cholla Bay Sportsman's Club shall be Forty Dollars (\$40.00) per Calendar year.

Number 2: Change:

ARTICLE V - Section 2: (B)

From: The dues for all memberships in the Cholla Bay Sportsman's Club will be Thirty dollars (\$30.00) per calendar year.

(a) The membership shall include a single member or member and spouse, plus all sponsored children eighteen years of age and under. However, only one vote per membership will be counted for voting privileges and member count.

To: The dues for all memberships in the Cholla Bay Sportsman's Club will be Forty dollars (\$40.00) per calendar year.

(a) NO CHANGE

Number 3: Change:

ARTICLE V - Section (E)

From: All dues paid into each member chapter shall be divided in the following manner: 80% shall be paid, within thirty (30) days to the Council treasurer and 20% to remain in the member chapter treasury.

To: All dues paid into each member chapter shall be divided in the following manner: \$39.00 shall be paid, within thirty (30) days to the Council and \$1.00 to remain in the member chapter treasury.

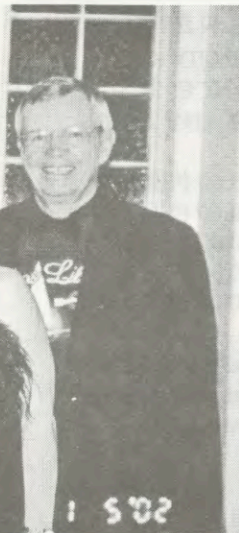

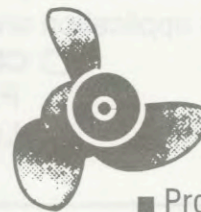

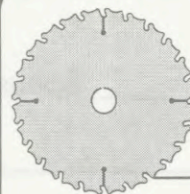
