

Some of you had to take special time off your jobs in order to get here on a week-day during the hours the bank is open in order to be able to sign for your trust. Mr. Alan "Pete" Peterson, President of the Vecinos De La Cholla, has informed us the second group of 139 bank trusts have been delivered to Bancomer. The bank realizes how difficult it has been for people to get time off work to correlate time and days with them so they have devised a plan to make it more convenient for you to get your trust. They have provided Mr. Peterson with a form you can sign giving him the authority to pick up your trust and he can either send it certified mail to you or you can pick it up personally at his cabin #M 51-1. Pete also informed us the third group of applications are now in route for completion. 




These Things Stay




The OBSC held another gala New Year's Eve Party this year with about 120 members and Guest. The annual Mardi Gras will be coming up in February.
