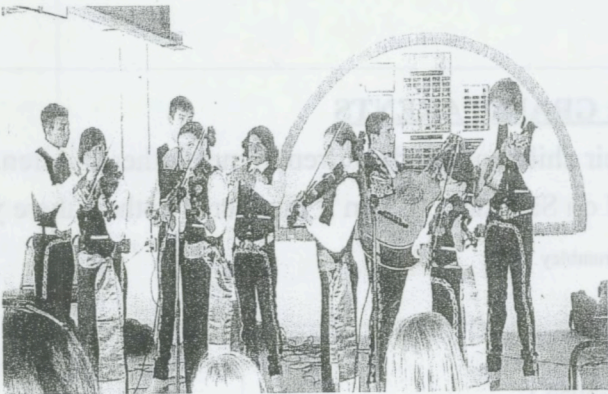

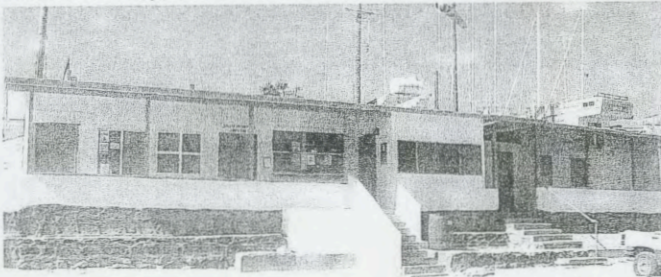
FISH FRY
