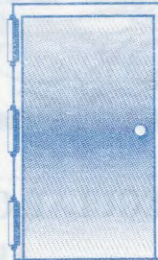

Let's Go Fishing, from the Launching Pad, via Rosario Villa

They removed the above mentioned trailer and another broken trailer which had been on the beach for some time, plus a blown out tire and other unsightly debris from the beach.

There were not many boats out for the derby but a few changes were made on the leader board. Sharon and James Dick brought in calico and also Tim McFarland. Tim Bottcher and Jay Verhasen on the Freedom Won brought in some nice pinto, also Craig McFarland. Tim McFarland topped the sardinero category. Bud Hamblen got a nice flounder from shore. Junior fishermen Chandler and Chase Canant joined the derby and weighed in fish caught from their boat, Chandler, a trigger and Chase a miscellaneous species.

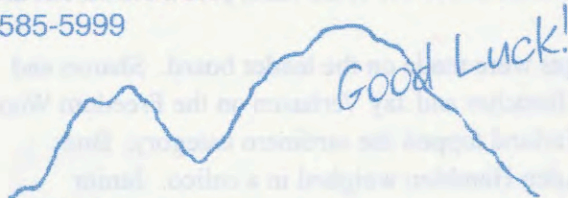

NEWS FROM THE LAUNCH AREA/RADIO SHACK

If you go down to the Radio Shack/Launch area, you may see something (or someone) you haven't seen before. During the last derby weekend, the Port Captain asked permission to use our radio room and facilities, at least during the Easter weekend and the fishing derby weekends. They will be checking pongas for correct permits, may check our boats for equipment (although they didn't look into any of our derby boats this past fishing derby). They have a huge banner on the wall, which is all in Spanish. Basically what it says is that you need to fill out a permit before going out, and the other rules as listed below. Our launch permits have been OKd by the Port Captain.

Other rules are as follows:

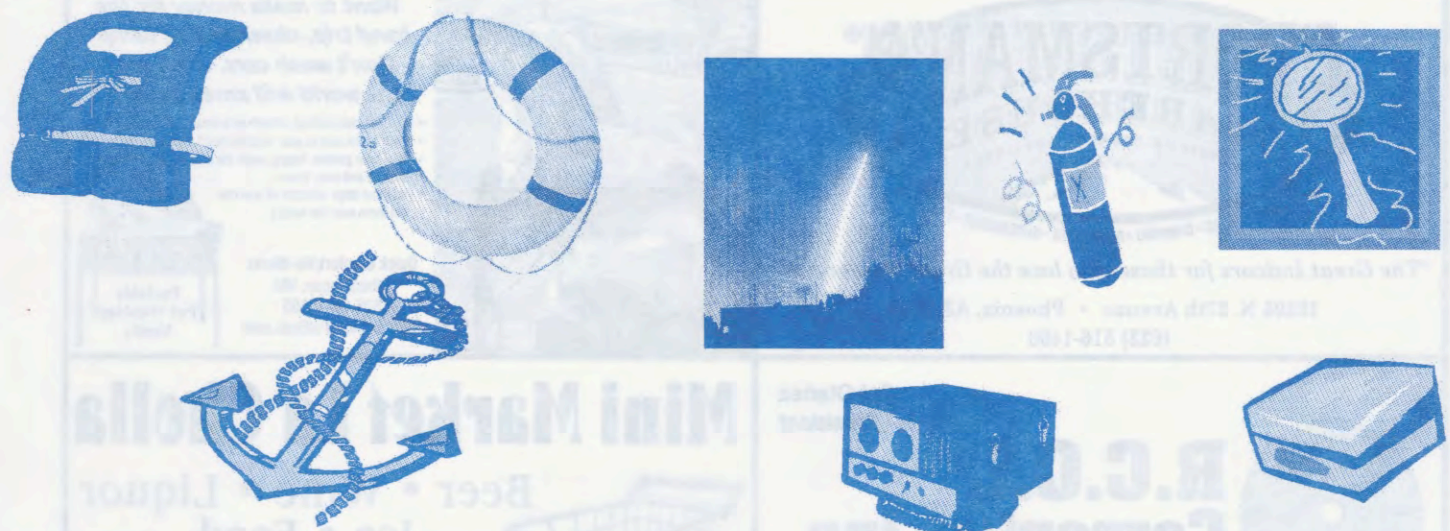
- Rules of maritime traffic and prevention approaches (not sure what that means)
- Maintain a prudent distance from the beach and bathing areas
- Maximum authorized speed is 25 knots (46km/hr) in open water, 4 knots (7.5 km/hr close to port)
- Exceeding 25 km/hr winds, nautical tourism activities remain suspended and shall resume to port
- Conductor of vessel should not drink alcoholic beverages, as there is a risk of sanction.

We have had one person from the Port Captain's office at the Radio Shack each day since the beginning of the 2nd derby weekend. They plan to be there during the Easter weekend to try to see that everyone is safe. They intend to have an ambulance on hand in case one is needed. If you have been down around that area during an Easter weekend, you will agree that someone official is needed there. Also, during the fishing derby, there were two trucks with "federalies" who stayed around for a time, and then came by often. Our local police were coming by about every hour also.

They are really nice people, and it is good public relations between CBSC and the Puerto Penasco officials. It's great that they are taking such an interest in our activities. The Port Captain told me that they want to be here for all of our activities which have to do with boating. They are also trying to keep the actual launch area free of swimmers and vehicles so that no one gets injured.

So --- Now you know what's new around here!

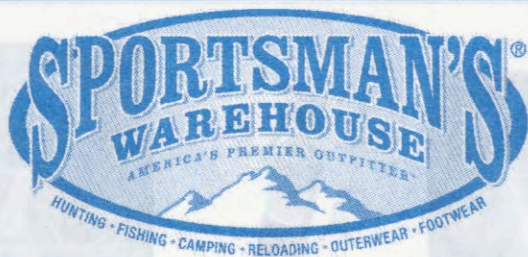

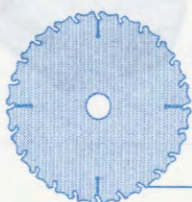

The CBSC conducts an annual Fishing Derby, hosts numerous events, publishes the "CHOLLA CHATTER" Newsletter, and promotes good relations between American visitors and our Mexican neighbors.
