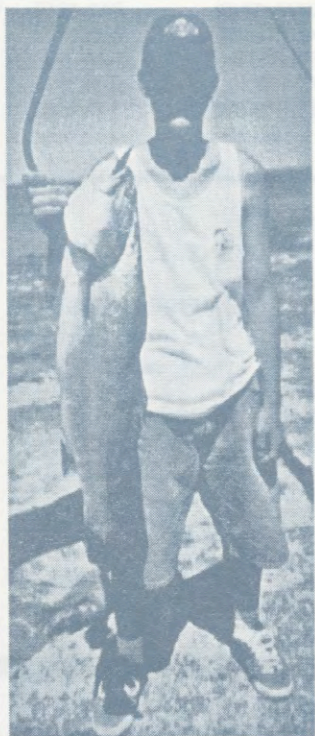




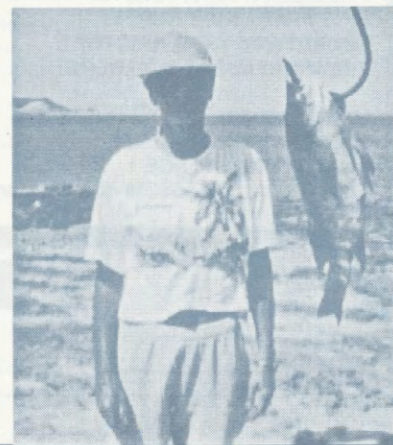

DERBY INFORMATION

Attention CBSC Derby participants and others launching boats from Cholla Bay. Boat permits and fishing Licenses - 05/10/01. We have been informed that boat permits: Permiso Para Utilizar Embarcacion and individual fishing licenses - Permiso Individual - are required for all recreational fishing vessels in the Puerto Penasco area. Apparently no permit is needed when fishing from shore. We are told the Mexican Navy has several high-speed boats and is beginning to enforce this policy. If approached by a Navy boat, stop, be prepared to present your permits and cooperate fully. They are Armed! At the present time, these permits are only available at the SEMARNAP (Secretary of Fisheries) office in Puerto Penasco. This office is in the harbor area of Puerto Penasco. From Cholla Bay, turn right just before the railroad tracks and continue about 3 blocks beyond the signal on the road to Playa Las Gloria's, then right about 1/2 block to a small unsigned building behind the CASAMAR hardware. This is the building in which Z F (Federal Zone) administrator Mario Chavez has had his office for the past 2 years. The hours are 9:00 am to 3:00 pm weekdays and 9:00 am to 1:00 pm Saturdays. You must have the current U.S. registration for the boat, and the name and address of each person who will be fishing from the boat. For children 12 and less permits are not required, although there is no statement of age on the applications. You will be instructed to fill out an application for the boat and each person fishing from the boat. The assistant to the local Delegation will fill out the permits from your application. It is a rather lengthy and tedious procedure. The permits will be signed and stamped by the local director and money collected. The Director speaks limited English and the assistant almost none. It is not necessary for each individual to make application personally. One person can make application for the boat and individual permits. The annual fees are \$281.00 (about \$31.00) for boats 7 meters (approx 23) or less, \$563.00 (about \$62.00) for boats between 7 and 9 meters, (approx 23 to 29 1/2) and \$843.00 (about \$94.00) for boats over 9 meters (approx 29 1/2). This fee includes the fishing permit for the owner of the boat. The individual fees are \$370.00 (about \$41.00). Daily and monthly permits are available at much lower rates. If payable at much lower rates. If paying in dollars have enough \$1's and \$5's along with larger denominations as change is unlikely.

In recent years, permits have not been available in Cholla Bay and enforcement has been nearly non-existent. Those of us who have not had permits have been having a free ride. The free ride seems to be ending. For the present May 10, 11, 12 Derby weekend it seems unlikely the local fisheries personnel will be coming to Cholla Bay. Attempts are being made to have the applications and permits available at the Radio Shack on Memorial weekend. You must have the current U.S. registration for the boat, and the name and address on it.

Next meeting will be June 12th, 2001 and will be the last one for the summer.

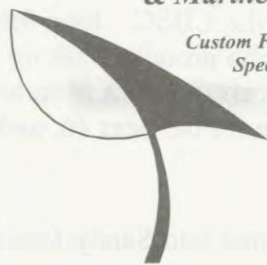
Cholla Chapter News
