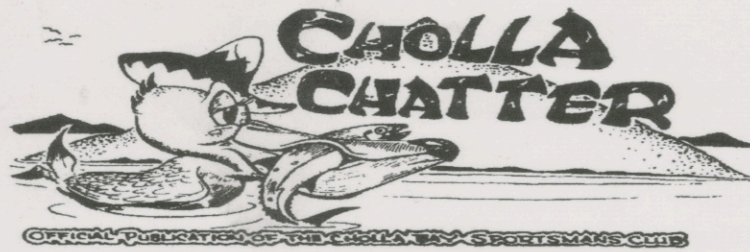

BOATER'S NEWS**LAUNCH PERMITS**

Don't forget to fill out a launch permit before having your boat launched. LEAVE THE WHITE PART AT THE RADIO SHACK AND, UPON RETURN PLEASE TURN IN YOUR YELLOW COPY. This helps the radio shack personnel to know which boat is still out at the end of the day. This is not a new rule, but very often the yellow slips are not being returned.

Please fill out the launch permit completely. These permits are a great help in the event you break down or get lost out there. It's a big ocean. If you decide to change your destination, you can call Villa or your launcher to make the change.

You might also want to include your cell phone number if you will have one on the boat. This could be a big help in case you lose the battery power on your boat and not be able to use your VHF radio.

There has been one search and rescue incident. Two jet skis were launch but did not return by late afternoon. The Port Captain sent a ponga out of Rocky Point to look for them but to no avail. Later, about 8:00 p.m. a smaller ponga found them off Black Mountain and towed them in. A large, dead sea lion, the Mexicans call them "lobos" washed up on the rocks to the left of Tucson Beach and is causing a big stink! Hopefully, Villa will soon get permission from the Port Captain to burn it. It has been there for over a week and the smell is drifting all along the beach and somewhat inland. There were not very many people on Tucson Beach this weekend!

The VH radio repeater is up and working but when Villa and Mike Dugan went to Rocky Point on a routine check, they learned that we do not have the written permission to operate this repeater. All boats in the area use this repeater so it is very important to their safety that this repeater is in operation. Evidently written permission must be obtained from officials in Hermosilla. Villa and the Port Captain will need to go there to obtain this permission. Hopefully they can do this before the Army comes and takes the repeater, as they did once before.

Hopefully, there will be more fishing activity for the next issue. Until then, hasta luego.
