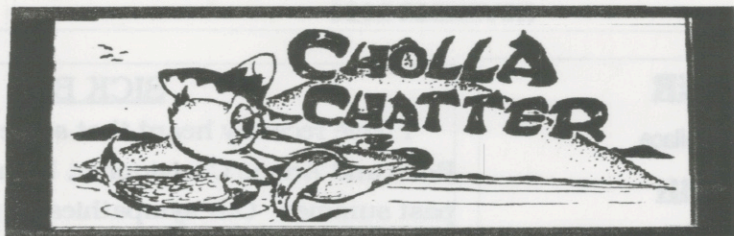


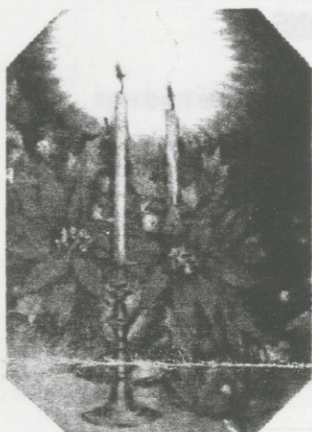

**COOK'S CORNER**

**FLAKY BAKED FISH**

- 2 Pounds fish filets
- 1 cup dry potato flakes
- 2 - 3 T. dry onion soup mix
- 1 cup milk
- salt and pepper to your taste

Mix together potato flakes and onion soup mix. Dip fish in milk and then in dry potato flake and onion soup mixture. Bake for 20 minutes at 350 degrees, or until flaky and crisp.

**CHERRY ANGEL CAKE SQUARES**

- 1 Loaf Angel Food Cake
- 1 can (1 lb., 9 oz) Cherry Pie Filling
- 1 carton (8 oz) Non-Dairy Whipped Topping

Slice cake into one-half inch thick slices and line bottom of 8 or 9 inch square pan with the slices. Cover with one-half of pie mix. Press mix into the cake with back of a spoon. Cover pie mix with rest of cake. Mix remainder of filling with 1-1/2 cups of the whipped topping and spread that over the cake slices. Cover and refrigerate until well chilled. Serve with a spoonful of topping if desired.
