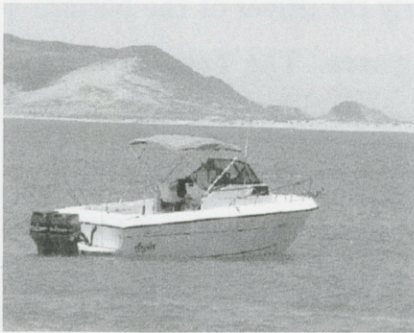

COOK'S CORNER

Party Chicken

from Adriana

4 to 6 boneless skinless chicken breasts
1 small jar dried beef
1 can cream of mushroom soup (special recipe)
1/2 cup sour cream
1/4 cup dry cooking sherry or other dry wine
2 TBS olive oil

Line a baking dish with slices of dried beef and set aside. Place olive oil in a skillet and brown chicken breasts. Arrange browned chicken breasts over dried beef, laying them side by side single layer. Mix remaining ingredients in a mixing bowl and pour over chicken being sure to cover all of the chicken. Bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes. Do not add salt, as dried beef is salty.

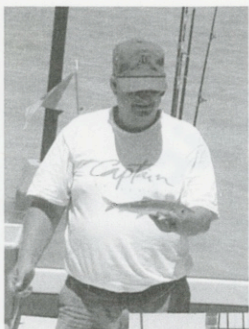
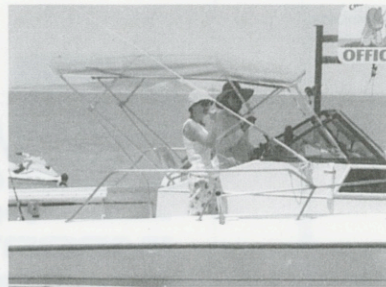
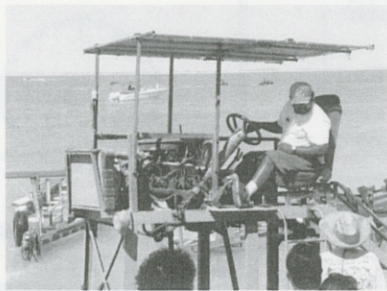
