The drainage patterns, vegetation and organ-rupted irreparably by off road driving and the village is rutted by tire treads.

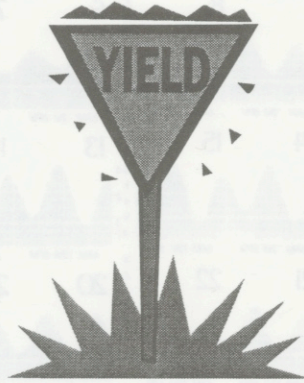
I am at a complete loss to explain why we insist on treating our natural surroundings with such little respect and why we seem inherently bent on abusing and defacing our own recreational environmental!

**FISHING DERBY**

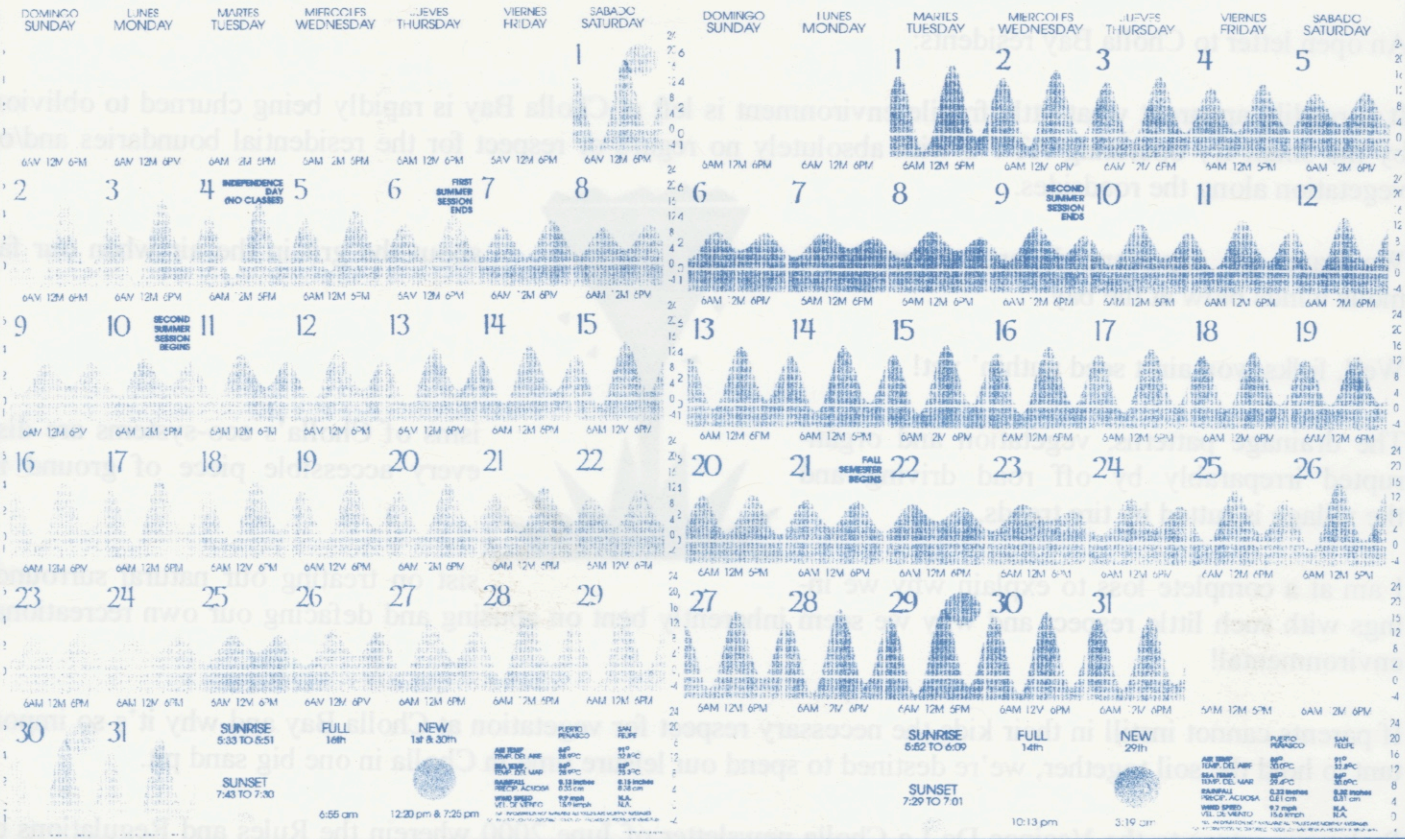
