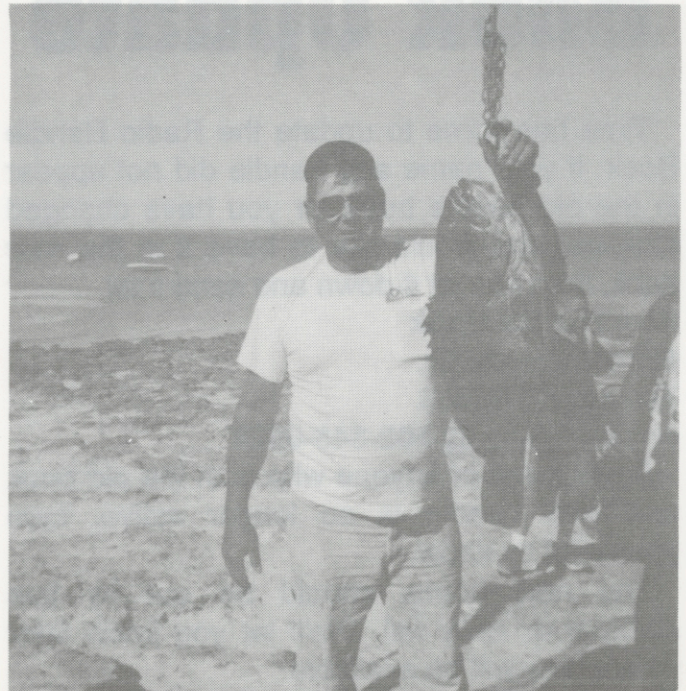
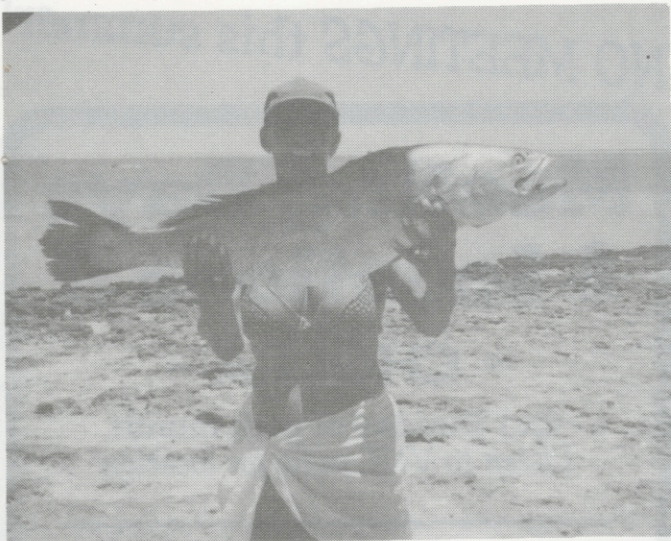

It seems that the shore or at least close to the shore might have been the place to fish this year, as there was a 21lb and a 15lb. orangemouth corvina caught from shore.

This year we had 105 derby participants. Augustin said that there were 219 boats launched during the derby weekends. There was a lot of categories of fish that went unfilled this year, if fact out of a possible 174 trophies, only 62 were presented. Overall the derby was successful and everyone who participated or helped out seemed to have a good time. Hopefully the fish will cooperate better next year.



Memorial Building Fund

If you read last months Chatter you know that the Fry Shack was broken into and vandalized a couple of times this spring and is in need of repair and being secured. In the hope of doing this council has established or re-established the memorial building fund. We are seeking donations by members and memorial donations also. Ultimately we want to make this building usable all year around and be able to have more functions there. It is the Club's very valuable asset and we would like to see it become the structure as it was originally designed or maybe even better.

Frank Prieto put in several dollars every time the can passed him at the Steak Fry and the Fish Fry. Many others also put in money as the can was passed or as they passed by the can. Our thanks to all of you anonymous donors. Many more or us are making pledges of \$20 or more, that's what we are asking from each member to make this project a reality. Earlier this season we asked for ideas for a fund raiser to take place in the Fall. So far we haven't come up with anything, so any suggestions would be appreciated.

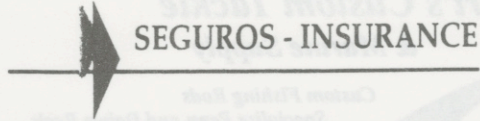

What About Fishin

One of the things I like best about Cholla Bay is the sportsmen. By that I'm referring to fact that if you're on the water and have a problem, you'll get help pretty darn quick. Augustin monitors the radio and is always there when you need him. Usually the closest boat will come to your aid. They'll either tow you in or help you fix what is wrong. If you need to borrow something, they'll lend it to you, not expecting anything but borrowed object returned. That is what I call a sportsman.

Unfortunately, there is a distasteful, new practice that has just gotten started in Cholla and that is the selling if GPS coordinates. I'm not talking about buying Wally's book either. I'm talking about paying big bucks for a GPS setting. Come on folks, do we really have to stoop to these kind of antics? There are a great many reefs off Cholla to fish and they hold a multitude of fish. Enough fish to last all of us and hopefully our kids a lifetime. Instead of selling GPS settings, why don't we invite people onto our boats or maybe buddy boat with someone new to the Cholla area. Al Scott founded the CBSC to promote fellowship and safety.

For those of you that don't know the headings and distance for most of the available reefs, Dave and Kelley Adams have graciously allowed me a bit of extra space this month so I can print the following map and coordinates. Make a copy of it or cut it out of the chatter to keep in your boat. Then when you need to, you can refer to it for a fishing spot. Remember this, take time once you've hit the reef to use your depth finder to study the bottom and find the fish. Without the proper preparation, even the most expensive GPS setting won't get you fish.

I hope this map helps you out and gives you a better understanding of where the reefs are in relationship to Cholla. Good luck and go catch Moby!

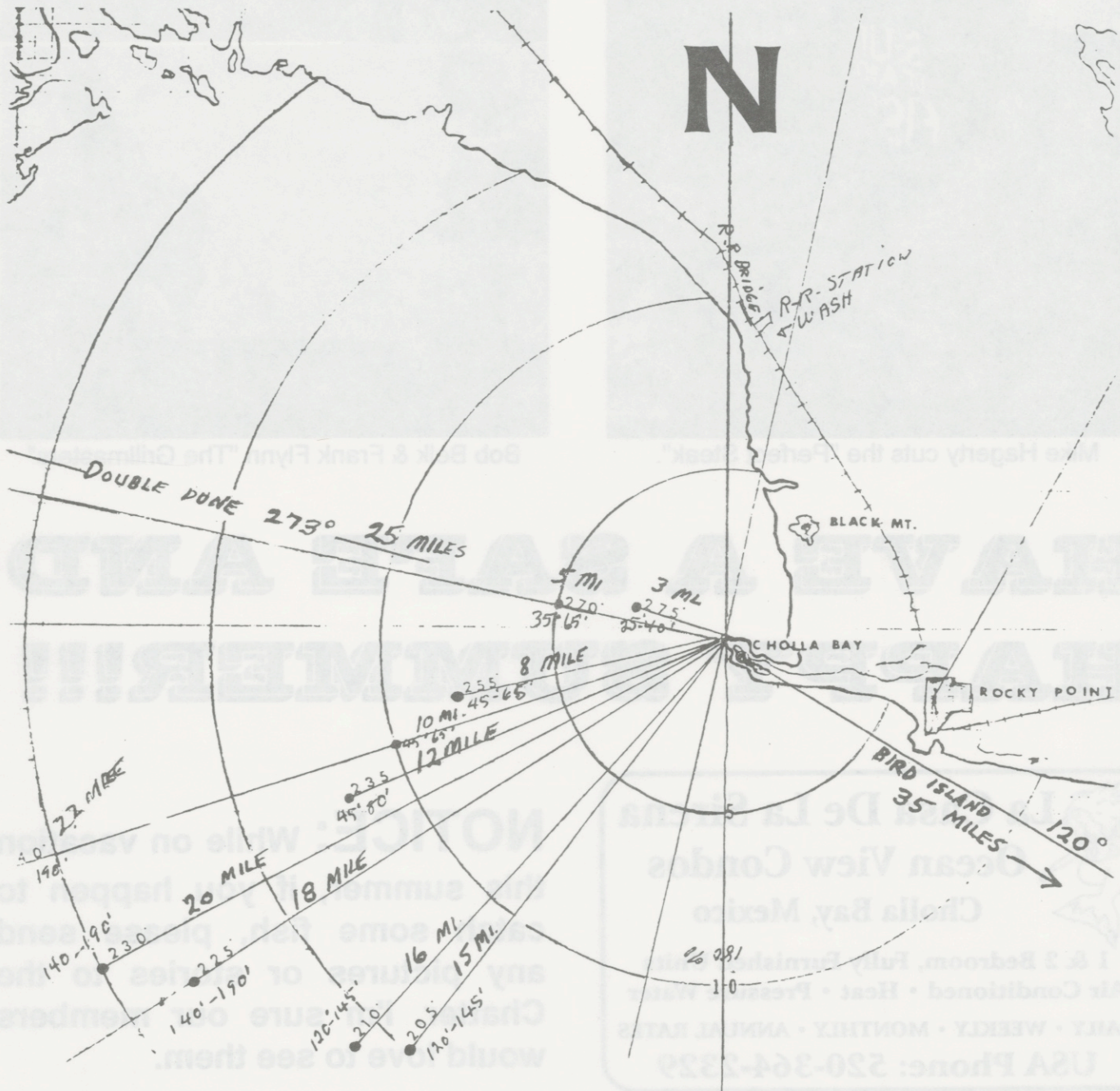

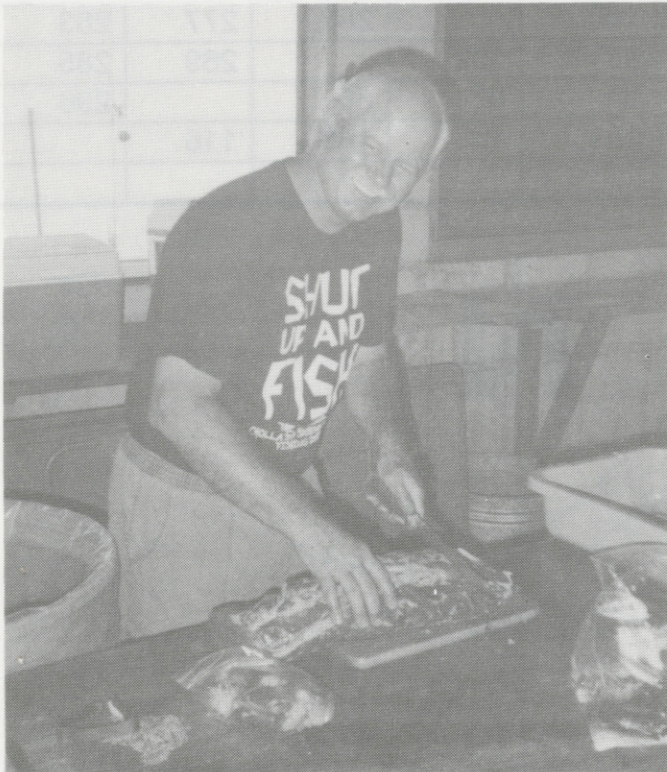

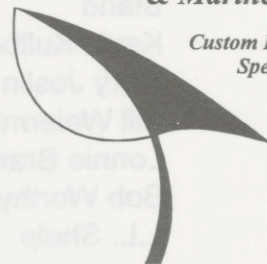
There is not much to cover with the club going into summer hibernation and all, so I will close this letter now. I wish all of you a very fun and safe summer.
