### Cholla Happenings During the Summer from President Mike Dugan:

It has been a long hot summer in Cholla this year with the typical winds from the south and the white caps on the Sea of Cortez. For those brave souls that come down or live year round here, life is pretty much the same, do things in the mornings outside, beach in the afternoons, and Margarita's in the evenings.

Your CBSC has not be idle in it's goal to make our club active. During the spring/summer time we have remodeled and repainted the Radio Shack. ( Sal Ortanz supervised the changes, gracias!) The concrete walkway to the west was removed, a large hole was found and filled with rocks, strengthen the wall and a new sidewalk was poured. Even a new "windsock" was installed! (Compliments of Rhea Dugan and her sewing machine!) All of the doors have been re keyed so as to eliminate the mass of keys that had to be used in the past ( Thanks to Hicks Lock and Safe, Bill and Tammy). I even broke my arm while making new benches along the front walkway. (Thanks Dr. Al for repairing it!)

Your CBSC has really had a face lift!!

As many of you know our launch area as well as Tucson beach has been inundated with commercial fisherman. At times as many as 80 pangas, trucks and trailers were amassed along the launch area, beachfront, and on private property in Cholla. Launching of recreational boats became almost impossible. Garbage was a daily affair. Tucson beach became another retrieval point for the pangas while people were swimming. Many of the members and homeowners complained to me asking to see if there was anything that could be done. Consequentially, I wrote a letter to the government officials requesting that they enforce the laws of the seas and the laws of the Mexican government. As a result, the port captain met with the fisherman and came up with a plan to relieve the problems of Cholla but allow usage.

A fair arrangement.

A point to note in his "decree" is that he recognizes the launch area and the beaches for recreational use.

By the way, due to some problems, we are now monitoring channel 28 instead of 26. So those using the radio need to please use channel 28.

As we move into the 2011/2012 season, I hope that all of you will be down to your homes to enjoy the Mexican culture that we know as Cholla Bay and participate in the activities that your Cholla Bay Sportsman's Club offers.

### From the Launching Pad Via Rosario Villa

As usual it was a long, hot summer, but fishing has been picking up with 10 to 14 launched in a two week

period. The fishermen have caught pinto and grouper as well as trigger. As the weather cools, if it ever does, the fishing should be good.

The "big news" down at the launching pad was the launching of 30 – 40 pangas daily causing many problems. For one, the fish remains being thrown on the beaches were causing a stink. And also they were filling the trash cans way beyond capacity. The stench was horrible. The panga fishermen were even launching on Tucson Beach which made the road down to the beach impassable.

Villa and Mike Dugan made several trips to town regarding these problems and talked with the Port Captain. He came out to Cholla to view the problems first hand.

As a result the Port Captain now requires any panga fishermen to get a "permisso" from him, which, when shown to Villa allows them to launch. 4 to 5 pangas a day now launch from Cholla. Also, the pangas may no longer park their trailers on the beach but can park in the area of the trash trailers.

The also can not dump fish remains or empty the water from their boats on the beach. Consequently the launching area looks and smells much better. There about a dozen search and rescue missions this summer with the pangas going to the aide of the fishermen, however, I have no names to report.

The weather is getting much nicer so Villa Says "Let's go fishing!"

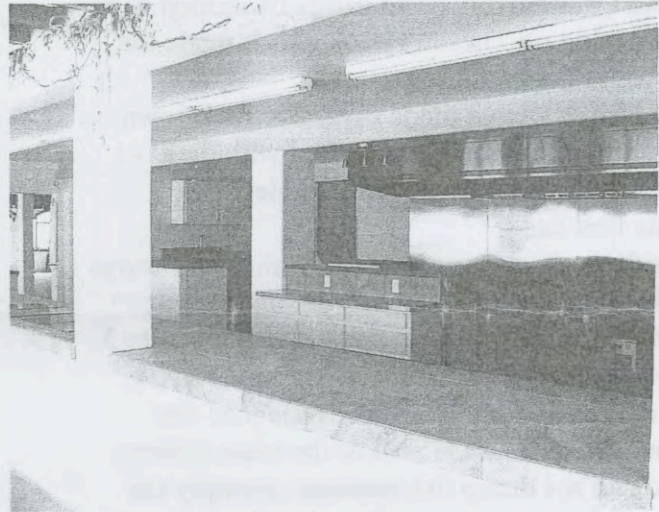
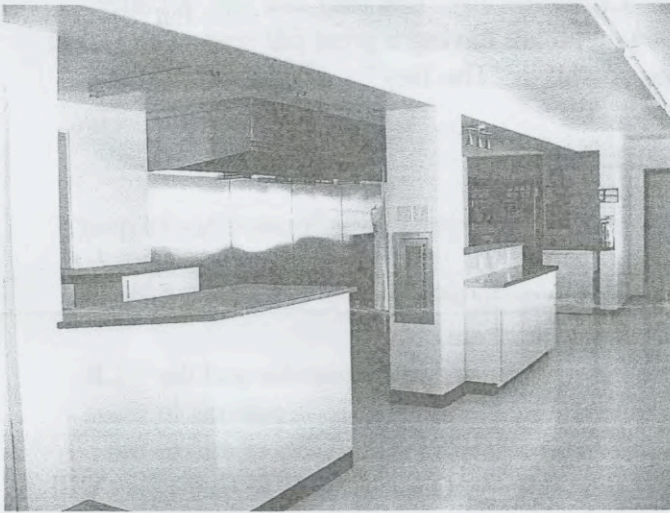
## CHOLLA BAY SPORTSMENS CLUB 5<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL HORSESHOE TOURNAMENT

**MEMBERSHIP NEWS**

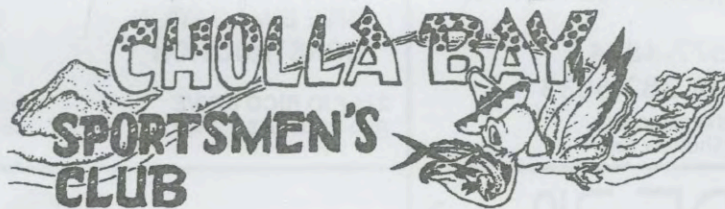
