# Let's Go Fishing Via Rosario Villa - Cholla Bay Launch Ramp Report

This month's big fish recognition goes to Munchy, the patio bartender at JJ's who brought a beautiful Gulf Grouper to the scale that weighed eighty five pounds. He was accompanied by Chino Leon on their usual Thursday fishing foray in Munchy's panga that often yields good results. Multiple other fish species were caught including pinto, spotted sand bass (estrenero) and Cochi. Muchas cervezas fueled the fish catching gold on an unusually cloudy but calm day on the ocean. The sportfishing craft Medusa out of Tonopah, AZ reeled in a fine catch of Pintos plus a hefty Sardinero earlier this month. The boat "Freedom Won"

landed five nice Pintos a week or so earlier out west when an extended period of wind free days made for great fishing weather. Very few boats took advantage as the tiny drinking village of Cholla Bay has a big fishing problem.

That problem is the constant assault on this fishery by commercial fishing interests showing zero regard for the future health and vitality of the northern Sea of Cortez. Overfishing with illegal gill nets and the baited traps of the "pangueras" have brought several ocean species including Blue crabs, Mexican White Sea Bass(totoaba), several Shark species and the Vaquita porpoise to near extinction levels. The gigantic shrimp trawlers with their deadly nets do the most damage while displaying little respect for regulatory efforts by Mexican authorities. Money talks and the ocean environment walks. With the total absence of Colorado River.water reaching the Sea of Cortez.due almost entirely to U.S. and Mexican farming and urban demands, the hopes for regeneration here are limited. Torrential rain fall on the Gila River watershed that would overwhelm the smaller water storage facilities there could provide an act of God scenario to reinvigorate the marine environment down here. At least we have something to pray for.

The Cholla Bay Sportsmen's Club endorses strict adherence to sport fishing catch limits set by Mexican fishing regulations in it's annual fishing derby(April 20-22, May 10-12 & May 24-26, 2018) and encourages all fishermen to comply with those limits whenever they fish in the northern Gulf of California. Let's go fishing.
