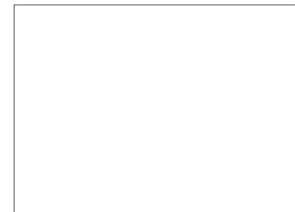
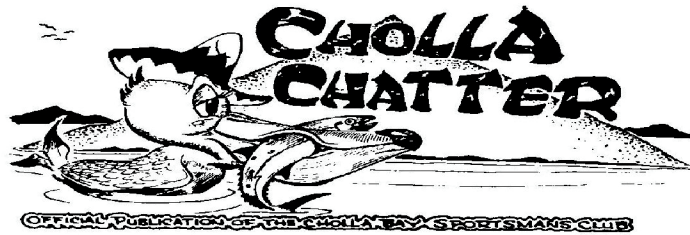

Two were towed in by ponga fishermen.
