A huge shout out of thanks to Ken Maroney for all his help with the last two tournaments! Without Ken, I would have “retired” last year and we wouldn't have a tournament.

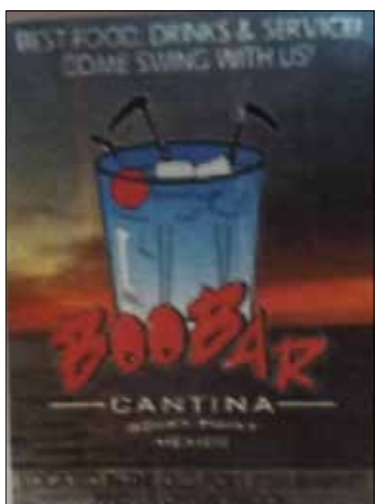
Another huge shout out of thanks to my co-chair Helen Dahlstrom for designing the T-Shirts, which all sold out, and for keeping me organized!

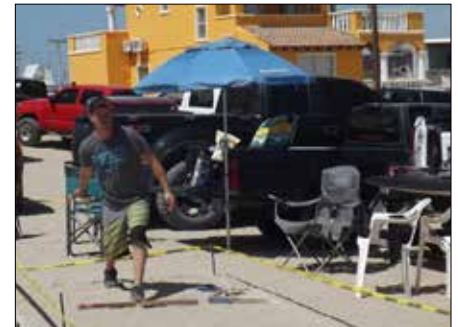

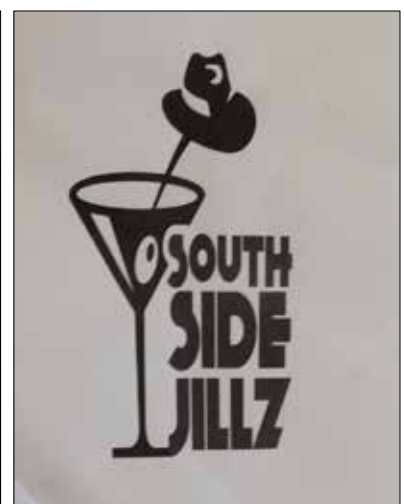
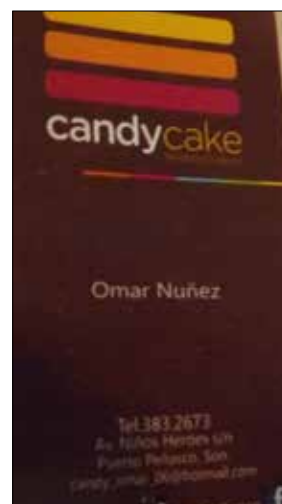
