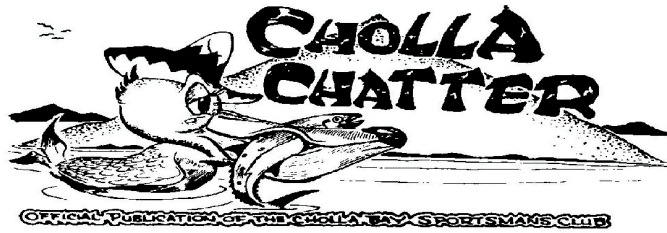

Let's Go Fishing, from the Launching Pad, via Rosario Villa:

Fishing was good the last week of April, but the last couple of weeks the wind has been very bad. No boats were able to go out the first two days of the second phase of the derby, May 7th and 8th but six to eight boats braved the calmer winds and went out the last two days, the 9th and 10th. A number of fishermen did fish from the shore and weighed in some nice catches. Please see Chuck's article about the

There have been no search and rescue since the last chatter, although one boat had to have the battery jumped and then was able to make it all the way in. However, unknown to me until Monday after the derby, on Sunday, May 10th, an eighteen foot fishing ponga was overloaded with conches and sank when the winds caused it to capsize about twelve to fourteen miles from Cholla. Two of the fishermen survived but one drowned. His body was later found washed to shore.

After two initial days of no boats launched, the wind finally settled down enough to allow boat fishing on Saturday and Sunday. Hats off to the shore fisher persons who kept the weigh station staff busy with their surf casting and kayak division catches. Those who took advantage of a calmer northern Gulf of California still paid their rock and roll ocean dues but managed to catch some fine fish anyway. Fish hard was the catch phrase as it was hard work to fish. Among the best catches were Pepe Rodriguez's 73 lb. Grouper, Mitch Callahan's 29 lb. Pinto and Lynn Altfillisch's 20 lb. Yellowtail. The target fish for Phase II was Cochi and that rod and reel prize was collected by Rolando Lisaraga with a 4.4 pounder. We can all hope for less wind and calmer seas along with good fishing for Phase III on Memorial Day weekend May 21-23 with the Fish Fry and Awards ceremony May 24.
