2016 Fishing Derby Recap

The marquee annual event of the Cholla Bay Sportsman's Club sixty one year history has been the Fish Fry and Awards Ceremony for the CBSC Fishing Derby. What part of 'free' don't people like.....not a thing! A good time was had by all in attendance as the temperatures were pleasant, the beer and margaritas cold and the food tasted great. Hats off again to the Rio Rico fish fry crew and Vasquez Liquor for making such a unique and enjoyable event happen year after year after year. The pulling together of several different groups of volunteers from the weigh station/boat launch, Ship's Store/T-shirts, Fish Fry, prizes, raffles, and sponsors as a team should make us all proud. Even though we can get a little testy with each other now and then, the end product is worth it. We all know that no one can cut our pay. They may want to let us go but they have to find another volunteer to take our place if they do. Rosario Villa and the Cholla Bay Mexican community do a great deal to assist the derby project. I can't imagine the chaos that would prevail at the boat launch without Villa sorting out the sport fishing boats and Mexican commercial fishing pongas. Commercial over fishing remains the greatest threat to the continued success of the fishing derby. Most of the time, when you have a problem in Cholla, local Mexicans have the solution or they will find out who can help.

Windy weather affected some fishing days but quality fish were still caught. Outstanding Pinto and Sardinero catches were made by anglers on the boat Chivo Viejo and the McFarlands (Craig&Tim) were neck and neck on their boat El Patron for the 'Adult All Around Angler' award won by Tim McFarland. Weekend target fish winners of rod/reel combos were Craig McFarland (Gulf Grouper), Pepe Rodriguez (Pinto) and Shaun Zark (6 yr old terminator of Finescale Triggerfish).

Years ago women weren't even allowed on fishing boats. Now they are taking over fishing craft just like everything else and demanding the prime spots on the boat to fish from as well. Next thing you know, they'll want to be Captain. The outstanding female fisherperson for this derby and leader of the JUG's (Just Us Girls) boat was Lynn Altfillisch with two big Pintos (43 & 42 lbs) and the first place Leopard Grouper (20 lbs). Maybe she'll teach hubby Jeffrey and some of us other guys how to do it before next year's derby. The 'Junior All Around Angler' Award went to Aden Hamblen aboard the boat named Jump Start for the second consecutive year. Aden won several categories of fish including Shark and Flounder and was awarded a Penn combo rod and reel for his efforts. Hopefully he will jump start his adult fishing buddies abilities to woo fish as they have to be tired of watching him catch most of the fish. We need to bring in some junior anglers to give Aden some competition because he's got four or five years before he's fifteen. Folks at the Fish Fry really seemed to enjoy the Junior Awards segment a great deal so let's get these kids off their phones and on the water to teach them how to make it happen rather than watch it happen. Hopefully we can do this derby thing again next year.

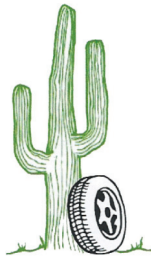

..Tale from the porch

There was a search and rescue operation on Saturday during the May 12th-15th CBSC Derby that was a throwback to the old days of Cholla Bay. By that I mean people having fun with a watercraft found their watercraft left high and dry by the tricky tides of the northern Sea of Cortez. A small water pumper ski boat got trapped by the outgoing tide well up in the Bay that afternoon. That dilemma fascinated the ladies of the Ship's Store porch to no end. They were present to support the Derby and be spectators for the boat launch goings on. What to do? What to do? With binoculars in hand, the women speculated and pontificated about many possible causes and solutions including alcohol might have been involved and why men were MIA when they were really needed. An amphibious vehicle was dispatched across the Bay toward the stranded craft with eight balloon tires and four axles churning up the shallow sea but it was ponderously slow and had little chance of saving the mud bound boat. 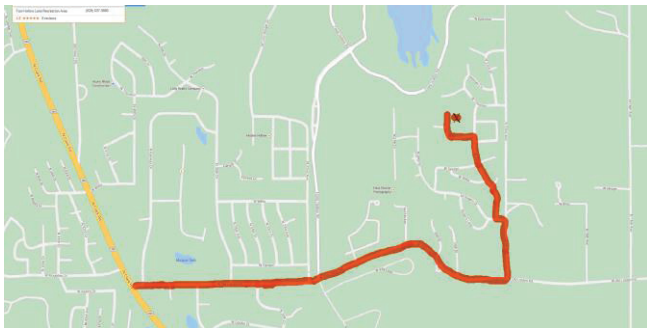
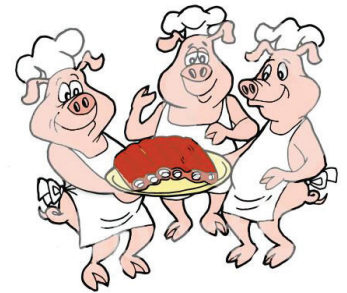

Membership dues and other activities of the CHOLLA BAY SPORTSMEN'S CLUB funded the purchase of radio equipment and continue to support the operation and maintenance of Marine VHF Radio (**Channel 28**) for the Northern Sea of Cortez. The CBSC pays the salary of the Cholla Bay Radio Operator, assists in search and rescue operations, and when necessary can assist with some arrangements for the emergency transportation of critically ill or injured. The CBSC conducts an annual Fishing Derby, hosts numerous events, publishes the "CHOLLA CHATTER" Newsletter, and promotes good relations between American visitors and our Mexican neighbors.
