Breaking News Flashes, if you are traveling to Cholla:

It is very sad and hard to believe, but three dogs have been poisoned in Cholla lately. Roger Burge, Doug Galinger and Susie Flinn all had their dogs poisoned. Roger's and Doug's dogs died and Susie saw her dog was ill and took it to the vet and the vet was able to save it. So if you are bringing a pet to Cholla or have a pet here, just be sure to keep them in your home and enclosure or watch for any sign of illness.

Also, the Mexican agents at the border are searching some cars and taking beef, among other things, but mostly beef, pork and dog food, because it has meat in it. Juliene Wallace and family had all their steaks taken. In one case they took pictures of the license plate and gave them a citation and told them if they were caught again they would be fined and possibly sent to jail. Of course there is a long list of things that are illegal to bring into Mexico, so they are just enforcing that law, which they seem to do sporadically. Although it is the law, this is not favorable to tourism, so hopefully, this too shall pass. When we came through on Tues. about 6:00 p.m. we got the green light and they didn't even look at us. Please don't let this deter you from coming, just thought you might like to watch what you plan to bring and be ready if they stop you.

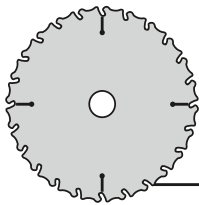

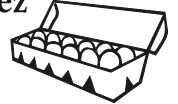
